General Carl Moyer Program and the Carl Moyer Program Grant Management System (GMS)

1. What is the solicitation period for the Carl Moyer Program?

3. How do I submit an application?

You may start, edit, and submit an application using the online portal at <https://gms.aqmd.gov/> Please keep in mind that you will need to register your company first in order to apply.

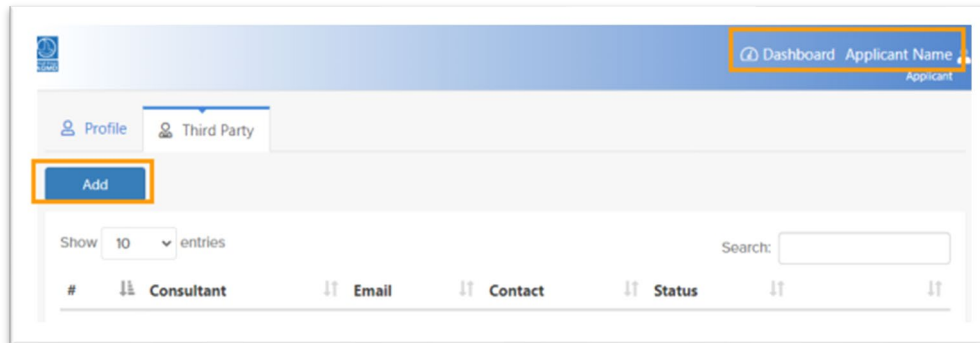
4. How do I add a third party?

Third parties assisting a client or company must register individually and create their own account to be added as a “Third Party” user.

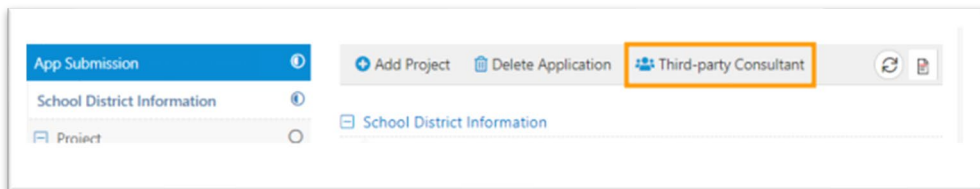

Once they have registered, applicants can add the registered third party to work on the application on the account profile or the application tab:

5. Am I able to save my application before I submit it for review?

Once you have created an application through GMS, users are allowed to save and continue from where you or the registered and added third party have left off in the application form. Third parties cannot submit the application for you.

6. If I apply for Carl Moyer funding in future years, do I need to register again?

If you register once within the Carl Moyer GMS, you will not be required to register again in future applications. Users are able to adjust their Personal Information, Company Information and Password Recovery Security questions under their Account Settings.

7. Can I contact South Coast AQMD staff thru the GMS System?

Yes, the Carl Moyer GMS has a built-in messaging feature that will allow the applicant to contact the assigned project officer assigned to review the application. Applicants can message the project officer who is evaluating the application directly within the GMS or through traditional methods such as email and/or phone.

8. Are there restrictions on the document type (.doc, .xls, PDF, JPEG, etc.) that I can upload into the GMS?

No, there are no restrictions. The Carl Moyer GMS will allow the upload of all document types, from Microsoft Word and Excel files to image files such as PDFs, JPEGs and GIFs.

9. How much total project funds will be available for this solicitation?

This solicitation will be funded by various funding sources, not only Carl Moyer Program funds, and up to \$200 million is expected to be available as funds become available from the various sources.

10. Is there a cap on how much funding a single business can receive?

There is no cap on how much funding a single business can receive.

11. Will projects be selected based on a first come, first served basis or by competitive solicitation?

Projects are evaluated and selected based on a competitive solicitation based on the criteria shown in the program announcement. Priority will be given to projects that can be commissioned in 2024.

12. Can I apply for multiple units/projects at the same time?

Yes, if you add a new project within an application, you will be able to add a new station at a different site location. you can add as many projects as you like in a single application.

13. Is co-funding or grant-stacking allowed?

Yes! Stacking is allowed in most cases. However, the Carl Moyer Program requests that 15% of the cost share is provided by the applicant/contractor. Please provide co funding source and amount in the application.

14. If selected, is there a penalty for withdrawing my application?

No, the programs available are entirely voluntary. There is no penalty associated with withdrawing at any time.

15. I see an option for alternative fuel stations with CNG, can I apply for natural gas station projects?

No, the GMS was designed for different types of project solicitations; however, this current solicitation is only targeting zero emission infrastructure.

16. I see items in the certification checklist that do not apply to my project type, do I need to select these?

Yes you do. The GMS was designed for all Carl Moyer equipment categories with a single certification checklist. You will be required to agree to all items before you can sign, but you will only be held to the ones that are applicable to your project.

17. I submitted an infrastructure project application with your last solicitation, should I submit a new application?

If you submitted an application in the spring 2023 Moyer solicitation, you do not need to submit a new application. Awards will be approved by the Board on February 2, 2024. Please speak to your project officer for more information. However, if you have an award from an earlier solicitation where work has not begun you may opt to submit a new application with an updated quote to request higher funding due to higher construction costs since original application.
