San Bernardino Work Plan Structure





- Air filtration systems
 - Ruben Campos Community Center
 - San Bernardino City Council approved project 11/7
 - Site assessment completed
 - Installation pending
 - Jurupa High School
 - Project to be concurrent with HVAC system upgrade
 - IQ Air to install filters
 - Installation completed during holidays
 - San Bernardino City USD Projects
 - School district will select two schools from among four possible sites



- UPS Truck Replacement Project
 - Contract executed in September 2011
 - Replacement of 40 diesel trucks with electric trucks
 - Currently upgrading electrical infrastructure
 - Existing electrical infrastructure not sufficient to charge 40 trucks
 - Older facility, needs new wiring, transformers
 - Delivery of new electric trucks delayed until August



- MOAs for three VOC Programs for San Bernardino approved by:
 - San Bernardino City Council at November 2011 board meeting
 - AQMD at December 2011 board meeting
- Three VOC Programs
 - Green Cleaner Program
 - Schools, daycare centers, government entities eligible
 - Up to \$100 per "green" dilution system incentive
 - Super-Compliant Paint Program
 - Non-profits, schools, government buildings eligible
 - Up to \$12/gal incentive to switch to <10 g/liter VOC</p>
 - Vehicle Repair Shop Brake Cleaning Program
 - Vehicle maintenance shops eligible
 - Up to \$500 to replace solvent aerosol cans with qualifying aqueous cleaning system



- Other VOC Project Updates
 - University of Northern Iowa signed MOA for Targeted Spray Coating Project
 - AQMD working on outreach materials for Targeted Spray Coating Project and Aqueous Brake Cleaning Systems



- Boiler Retrofits
 - San Bernardino County Board approved project at 11/15/11 Board Meeting
 - Proposal received from County of San Bernardino
 - Currently under review by AQMD
 - Project would replace one boiler at the San Bernardino Central Plant
