5. Issue RFP for Deferred Compensation Plan Consultant Services SCAQMD sponsors a 457 Deferred Compensation Plan for its employees. State law governs the fiduciary requirements for the operation and investment of 457 plans sponsored by governmental entities. This action is to issue an RFP for consultant services focused on assisting staff in maintaining the Deferred Compensation Committee Charter and Investment Policy Statements, providing analysis of plan assets and investment options, and administrative support. These consultant services will be funded by fees paid by plan participants that are returned through an agreement with the Deferred Compensation Plan record-keeper, MassMutual, and result in no cost to SCAQMD.
