PROPOSAL: Set Public Hearing April 5, 2019 to Consider Adoption of and/or Amendments to SCAQMD Rules and Regulations

Certify Final Subsequent Environmental Assessment and Amend Rule 1134 – Emissions of Oxides of Nitrogen from Stationary Gas Turbines

The adoption Resolution of the Final 2016 AQMP directed staff to achieve additional NO<sub>x</sub> emission reductions and to transition the RECLAIM program to a command-and-control regulatory structure as soon as practicable. Proposed Amended Rule 1134 applies to RECLAIM and non-RECLAIM stationary gas turbines and is being amended to update NO<sub>x</sub> emission limits to reflect current BARCT, establish ammonia emission limits, and provide implementation timeframes to facilitate the transition of the NO<sub>x</sub> RECLAIM program to a command-and-control regulatory structure. The proposed amended rule also establishes provisions for monitoring, reporting, and recordkeeping. Other provisions are incorporated to remove obsolete provisions and provide clarifications. This action is to adopt the Resolution: 1) Certifying the Final Subsequent Environmental Assessment for Proposed Amended Rule 1134 – Emissions of Oxides of Nitrogen from Stationary Gas Turbines, and 2) Amending Rule 1134 – Emissions of Oxides of Nitrogen from Stationary Gas Turbines. (Reviewed: Stationary Source Committee, February 15, 2019)
