SYNOPSIS: Staff is recommending membership for the AQMP Advisory Group

and the Scientific, Technical, and Modeling Peer Review (STMPR) Advisory Group for a new four-year term. The current term of these Advisory Groups has expired, and they are needed to assist

staff in the development of the 2022 AQMP. Staff is

recommending a four-year membership term because of the 2022 AQMP schedule. The AQMP Advisory Group is comprised of

representatives from environmental/community groups,

government agencies, academia, and business; and the STMPR Advisory Group includes experts in the fields of socioeconomic modeling, air quality modeling, air quality and meteorological monitoring, and atmospheric science. These Advisory Groups will

review and make recommendations to staff regarding the

implementation of the 2016 AQMP and development of the 2022

AQMP. This action is to seek approval of the proposed

membership rosters for the AQMP and STMPR Advisory Groups.

#### **Background**

In January 1997, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) Board formed six Advisory Groups to provide advice and recommendations to Board Committees and the Board on specific areas of expertise. In December 2002, the Board adopted the Blue Ribbon Panel recommendations regarding the duties and activities of the Advisory Council and the Advisory Groups. Since then, the AQMP Advisory Group and the Scientific, Technical, and Modeling Peer Review (STMPR) Advisory Groups have contributed to the development of the overall aspects of the region's AQMPs and have made recommendations concerning policy, control measures, socio-economic impacts, emission inventories, and modeling. Specifically, these advisory groups: 1) review and provide comments on: (a) studies relevant to advancing scientific and technical knowledge in support of AQMP preparation, (b) emissions inventory development and modeling approaches, (c) the development of new and revised control strategies, including on-and off-road mobile sources, and (d) socioeconomic data and evaluations; 2) foster coordinated approaches toward overall attainment strategies; and 3) assist in resolving key technical issues.

The AQMP and STMPR Advisory Group members are appointed by the South Coast AQMD Board. The proposed membership for the AQMP Advisory Group is comprised of a cross-section of diverse stakeholders and representatives from community/environmental groups, labor, academia, large/small business, local government agencies, and from proposed members of the STMPR Advisory Group. The proposed membership for the STMPR Advisory Group is comprised of experts in the fields of socioeconomic modeling, air quality modeling, air quality and meteorological monitoring, and atmospheric science. The previous membership rosters for both advisory groups were approved in February 2014 for a three-year term, expiring in 2017.

The next AQMP, which will primarily address the 2015 8-hour ozone standard in the South Coast Air Basin (Basin), must be submitted to the U.S. EPA by August 2022. To meet this deadline, staff are beginning work on the 2022 AQMP. To assist staff in the development of the 2022 AQMP, the AQMP and STMPR Advisory Groups need to be reconvened and their membership rosters updated.

#### **Proposal**

Staff is proposing new membership rosters for the AQMP and STMPR Advisory Groups to assist in the development of the 2022 AQMP. The Advisory Groups will also assist in the implementation of the 2016 AQMP (e.g., challenges regarding the 1997 8-hour ozone standard attainment in the Basin in 2023). The Advisory Groups will meet throughout the year at various frequencies (e.g., monthly, quarterly) depending on the AQMP schedule.

The proposed new membership rosters for the AQMP and STMPR Advisory Groups were developed based on the previous membership rosters. Members were confirmed or updated for organizations continuing to participate and new organizations were added based on recommendations from staff or advisory group members. The proposed membership roster for the AQMP Advisory Group is provided in Attachment A and the proposed STMPR Advisory Group is provided in Attachment B.

#### **Resource Impacts**

Existing South Coast AQMD resources are adequate to host the AQMP and the STMPR advisory group meetings.
