PROPOSAL: Set Public Hearing March 4, 2022 to Consider Adoption of and/or Amendments to South Coast AQMD Rules and Regulations:

Determine That Proposed Amendments to Rule 1115 – Motor Vehicle Assembly Line Coating Operations, Are Exempt from CEQA; and Amend Rule 1115

Rule 1115 - Motor Vehicle Assembly Line Coating Operations regulates VOC emissions from coatings and solvents used in operations conducted on motor vehicle assembly lines. Proposed Amended Rule 1115 reduces VOC emission limits consistent with Reasonably Achievable Control Technology requirements. In addition, the proposed amendment will update definitions, recordkeeping, and testing requirements. This action is to adopt the Resolution: 1) Determining that the proposed amendments to Rule 1115 – Motor Vehicle Assembly Line Coating Operations, are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, and 2) Amending Rule 1115 – Motor Vehicle Assembly Line Coating Operations.
