PROPOSAL:

Set Public Hearing February 2, 2024 to Consider Adoption of and/or Amendments to South Coast AQMD Rules and Regulations:

Determine That Proposed Amended Rule 461.1 - Gasoline Transfer and Dispensing for Mobile Fueling Operations Is Exempt from CEQA; and Amend Rule 461.1

Rule 461.1 applies to an owner or operator of a Mobile Fueler that conducts retail or non-retail gasoline dispensing operations. Proposed Amended Rule 461.1 will clarify that aviation gasoline is exempt from the provisions of the rule aligning with the original intent and applicability. The proposed amendment will also remove outdated rule language. This action is to adopt the Resolution: 1) Determining that Proposed Amended Rule 461.1 – Gasoline Transfer and Dispensing for Mobile Fueling Operations, is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act; and 2) Amending Rule 461.1 – Gasoline Transfer and Dispensing for Mobile Fueling Operations.
