

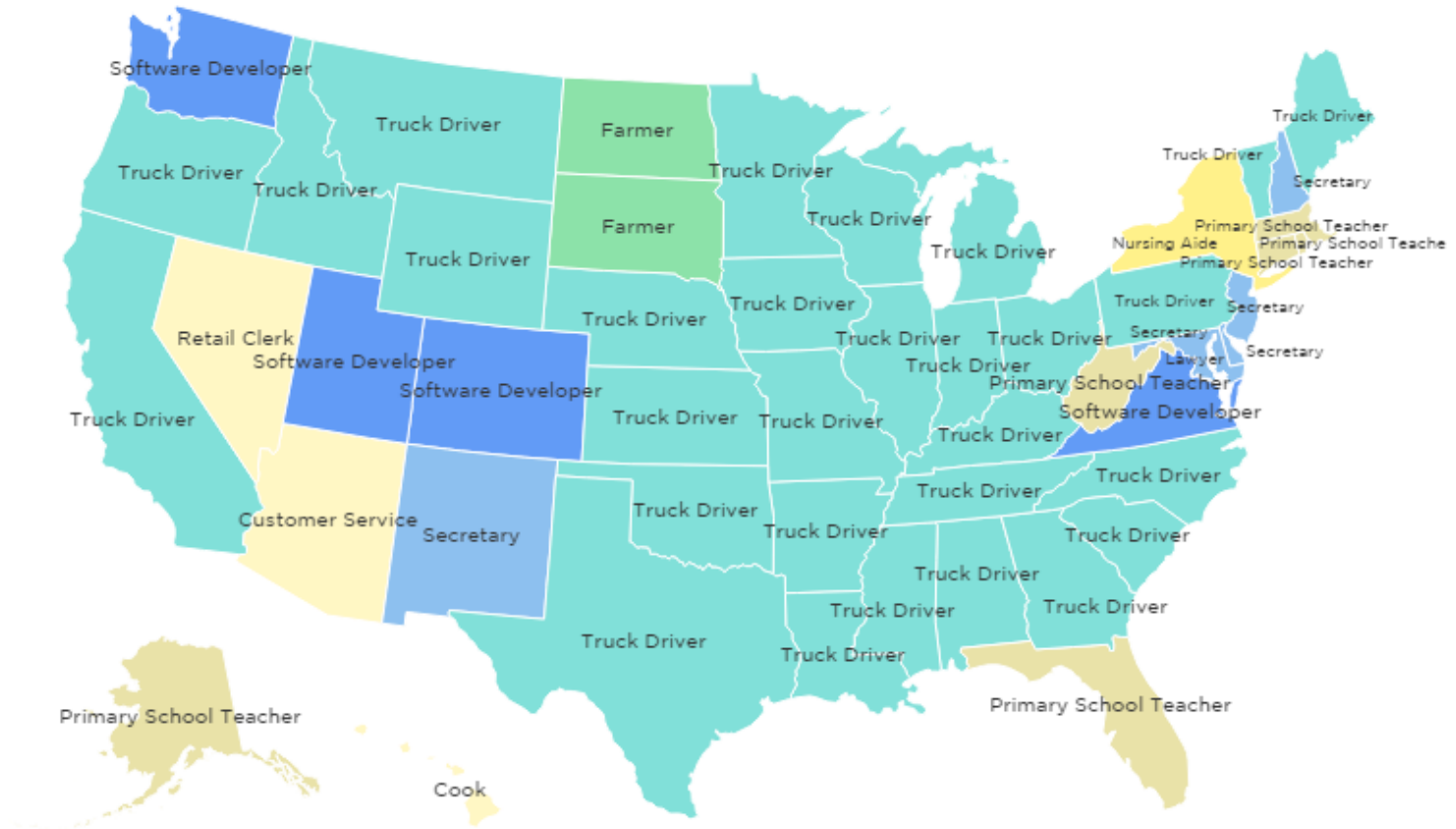

California's Truckers: Essential to Commercial Transportation

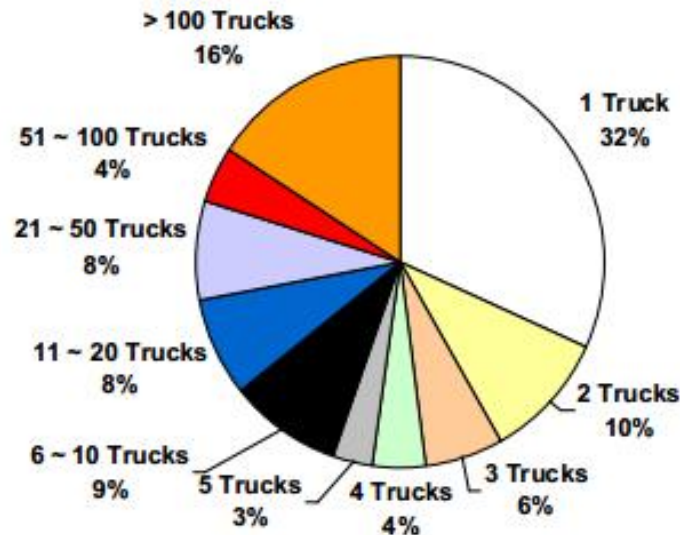
- 66.7% of All Freight by Value in CA

 - 48% of total fleet owns 3 or fewer trucks

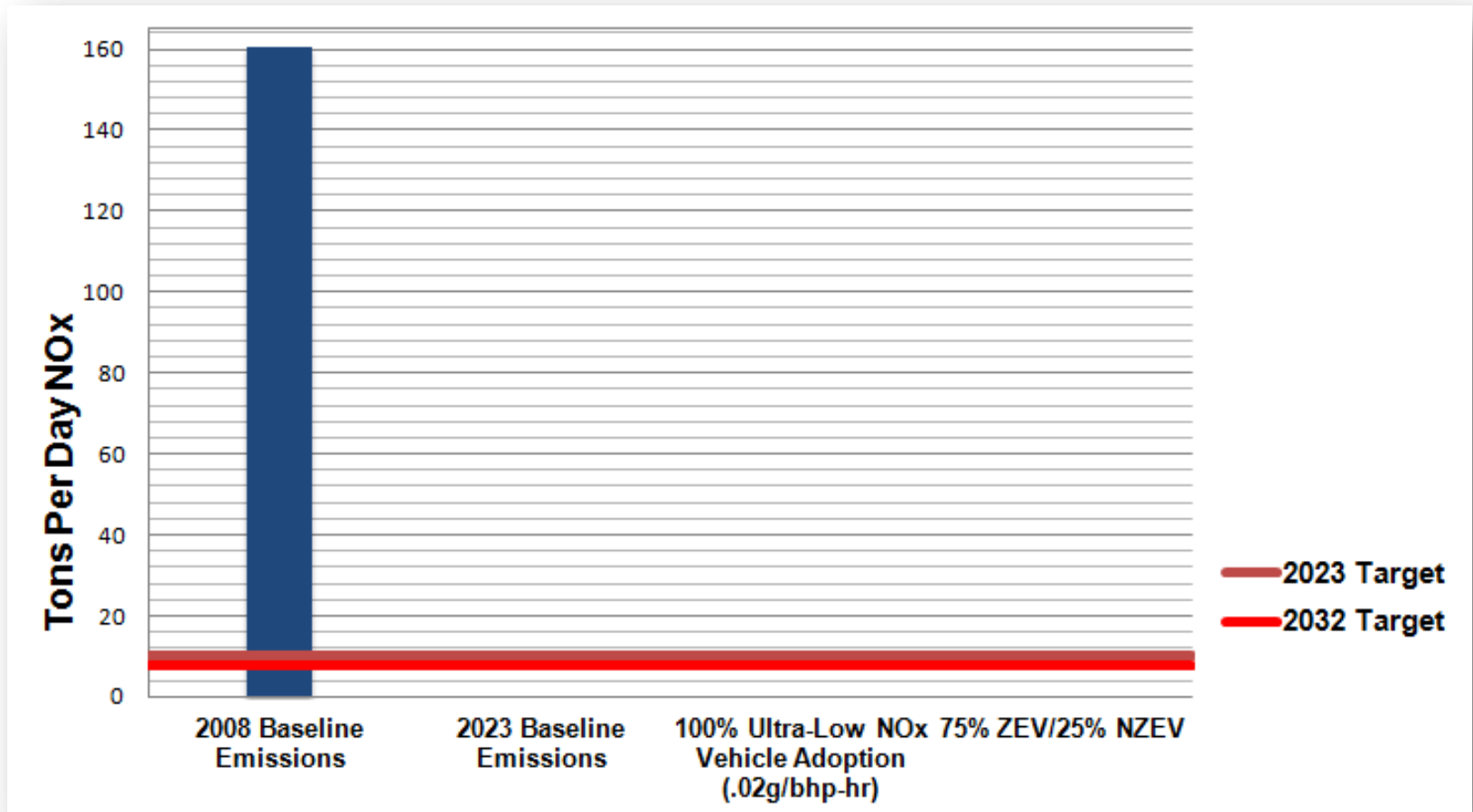
Figure III-3: Number of Trucks by Fleet Size (California Department of Motor Vehicles, 2006)



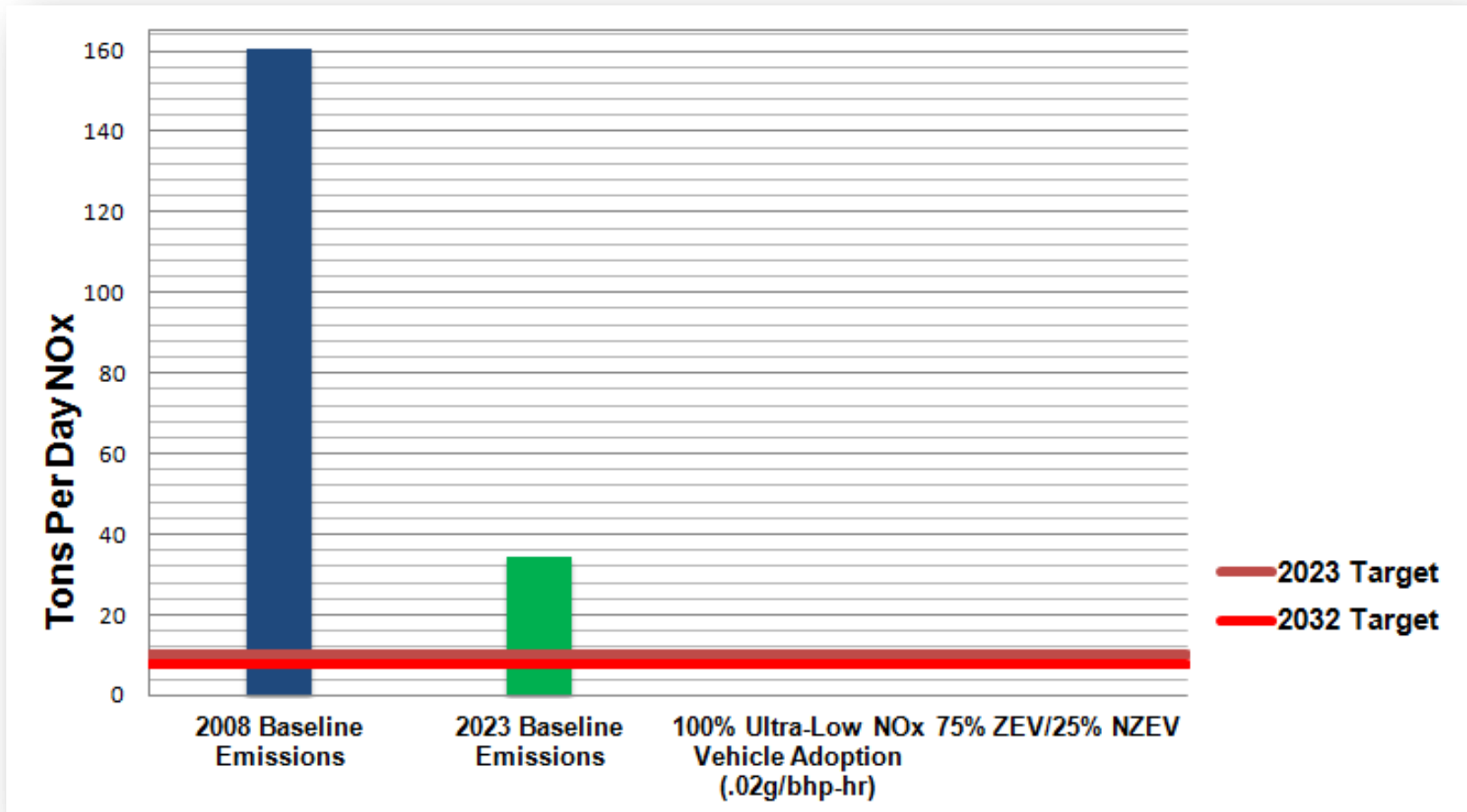

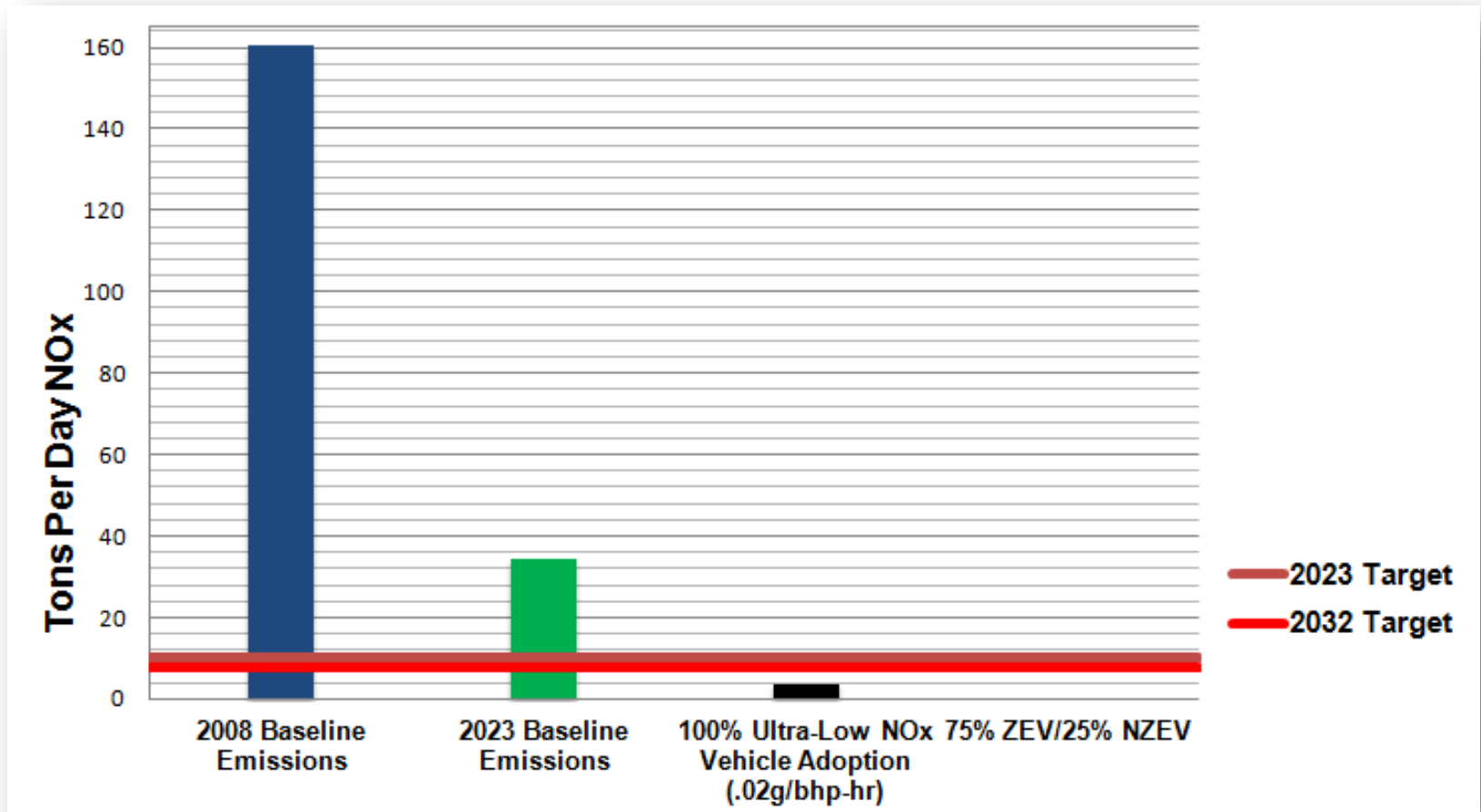

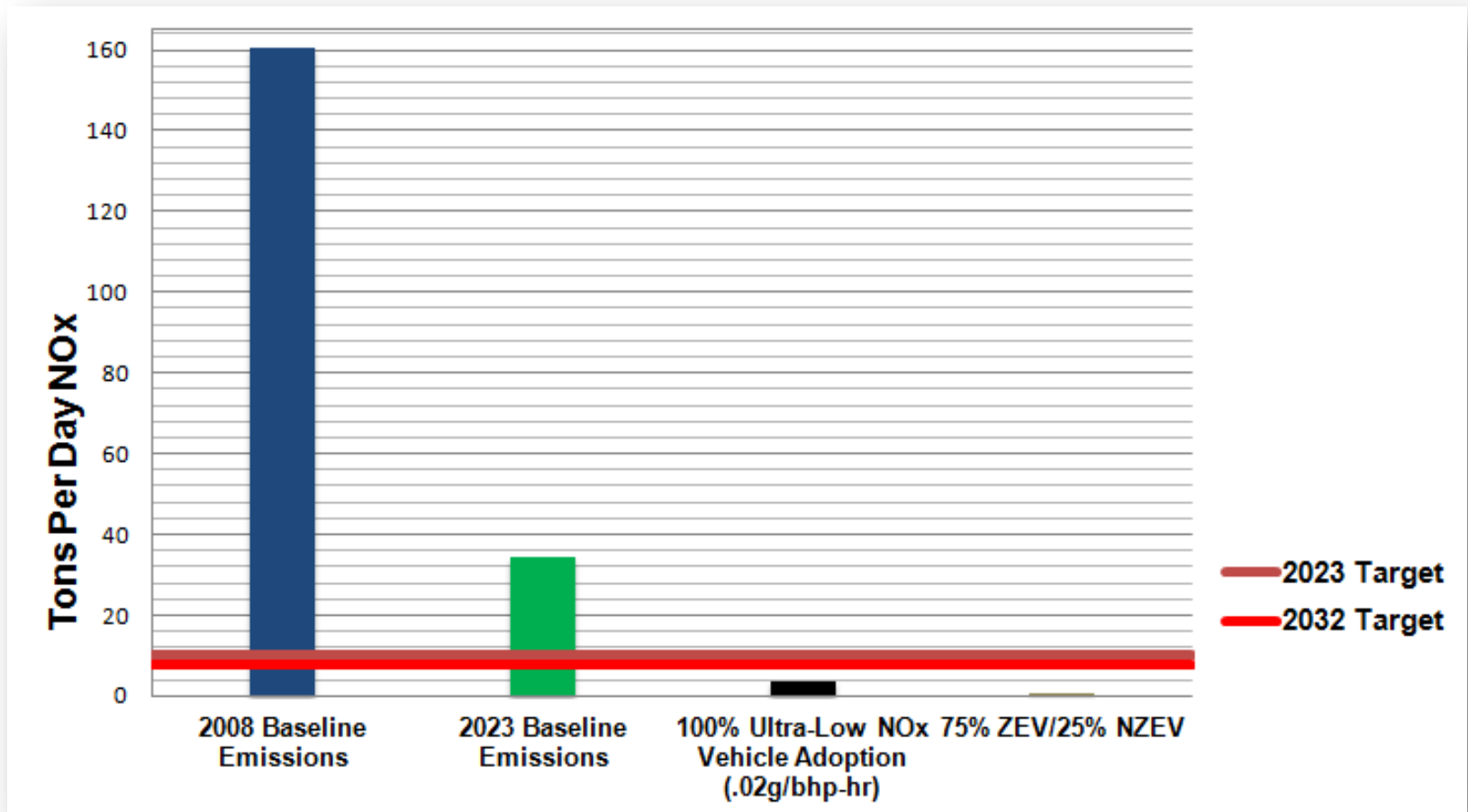

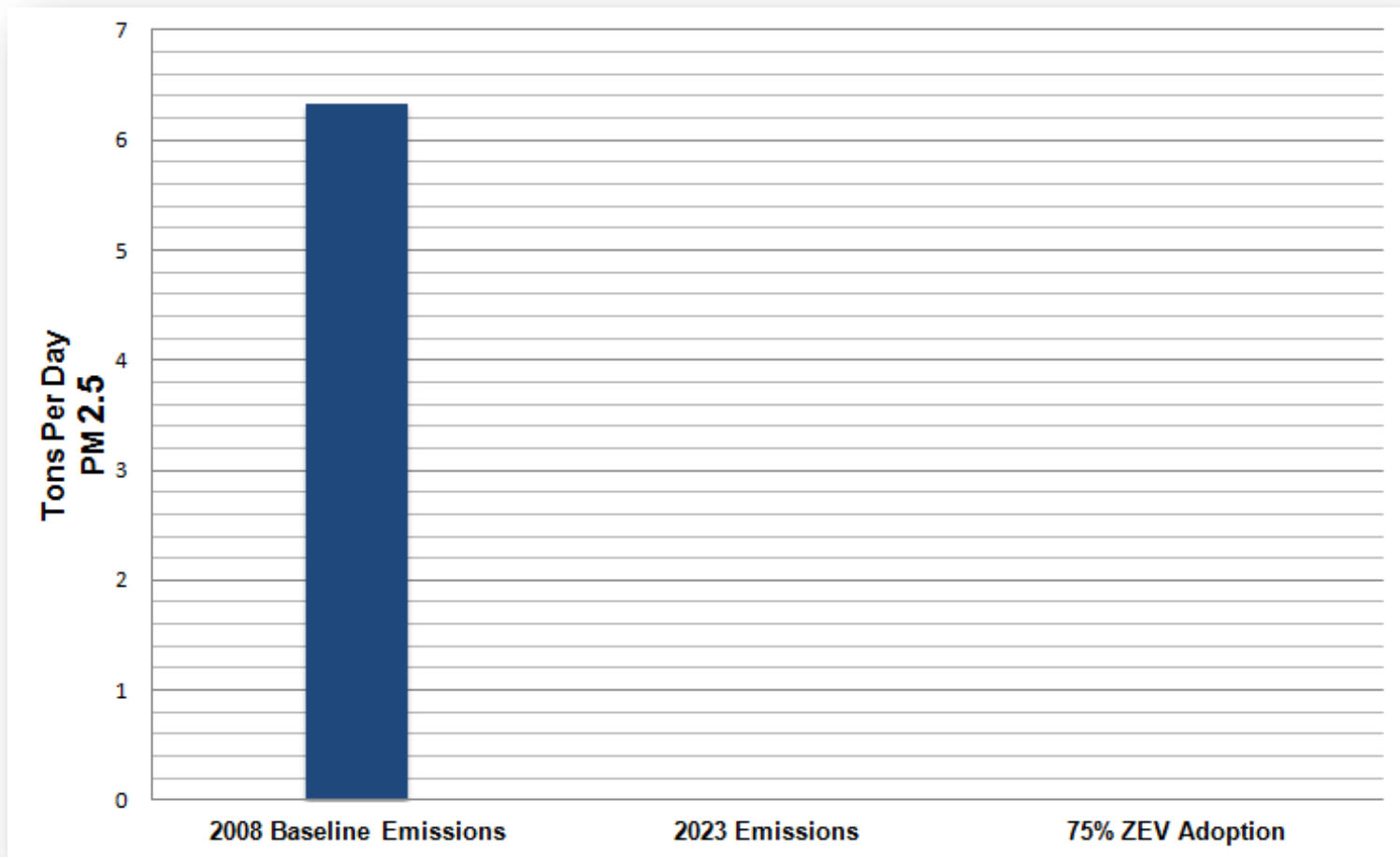

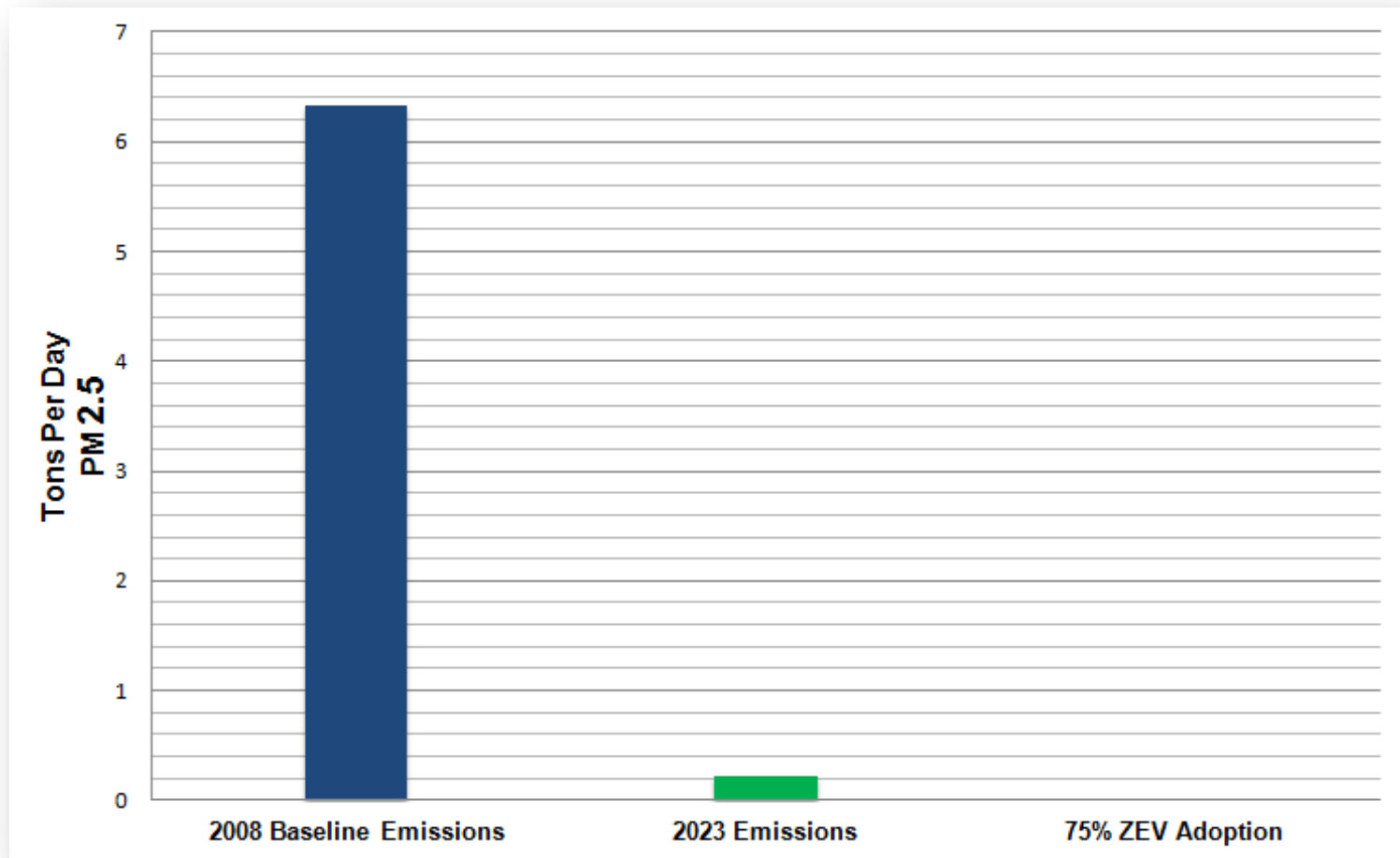
