	⇒ Thermal Oxidizer (Regenerative [burner operation only] & Recuperative [non-process emissions]), Natural Gas Fired <i>NOx limit: 30 ppmv for both Regen & Recup and CO limit: 100 ppmv for Regen and 250 ppmv for Recup on a dry basis @ 3% O₂</i>	
	⇒ Flare (Thermal Oxidizer), Liquid Transfer and Handling – Marine Loading <i>NOx limit: 30 ppmv and CO limit: 10 ppmv on a dry basis @ 3% O₂</i>	
	⇒ Heater- Other Process: Non-Refinery, Thermal Fluid Heater, Natural Gas Fired <i>NOx limit 9 ppmv and CO limit 100 ppmv on a dry basis @ 3% O₂</i>	
	⇒ I.C. Engine, Stationary, NSCR, 147 BHP and 385 BHP, Non-Emergency, Electrical Generation <i>NOx limit: 0.07 lb/MW-hr, VOC limit:0.10 lb/MW-hr and CO limit: 0.20 lb/MW-hr</i>
