# 2. <u>Consider Adopting Resolution for Continued Remote Meetings</u> Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361

Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361, the Hearing Board Advisory Committee (Advisory Committee), in order to continue meeting remotely, must, no later than 30 days after teleconferencing for the first time pursuant to Government Code Section 54953(e)(1), and every 30 days thereafter, adopt a Resolution finding by majority vote that the Advisory Committee has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency; and that State or local officials continue to impose or recommend measures to promote social distancing. This item is for the Advisory Committee to adopt the attached Resolution HBAC22-1 finding that it has: 1) reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency; and 2) State or local officials continue to impose or recommend measures to promote social distancing.

# 3. Public Comment Period

Members of the public are afforded the opportunity to speak on any agenda item before or during the Hearing Board Advisory Committee's consideration of the item (Gov. Code Section 54954.3).
