(d)	EX PARTE EMERGENCY: If variance coverage is required on a weekend or when the Board is not in session, and you cannot wait until an emergency variance hearing can be held, you may request an ex parte emergency variance. An ex parte emergency variance will be granted or denied solely on the information contained in the petition and the District's response to the petition. Under most circumstances, an ex parte emergency variance will remain in effect only until a hearing can be held. If you request an ex parte variance, you must answer No. 4 on page 1.				
(e)	INTERIM: If you require immediate relief (other than for emergencies) to cover the time until a short or regular variance hearing can be held, request an interim variance. - 2. THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE PROPERLY MAINTAINED AND KEPT IN GOOD OPERATING CONDITION AT ALL TIMES.
- 3. THIS ENGINE SHALL NOT BE OPERATED MORE THAN A TOTAL OF 200 HOURS IN ANY ONE YEAR WHICH INCLUDES NO MORE THAN 30 HOURS FOR MAINTENANCE AND PERFORMANCE TESTING.
- 4. OPERATION BEYOND THE 30 HOURS PER YEAR ALLOTTED FOR ENGINE MAINTENANCE AND TESTING SHALL BE ALLOWED ONLY IN THE EVENT OF A LOSS OF GRID POWER OR UP TO 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO A ROTATING OUTAGE, PROVIDED THAT THE UTILITY DISTRIBUTION COMPANY HAS ORDERED ROTATING OUTAGES IN THE CONTROL AREA WHERE THE ENGINE IS LOCATED OR HAS INDICATED THAT IT EXPECTS TO ISSUE SUCH AN ORDER AT A CERTAIN TIME, AND THE ENGINE IS LOCATED IN A UTILITY SERVICE BLOCK THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE ROTATING OUTAGE. ENGINE OPERATION SHALL BE TERMINATED IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE UTILITY DISTRIBUTION COMPANY ADVISES THAT A ROTATING OUTAGE IS NO LONGER IMMINENT OR IN EFFECT.
- 5. THIS ENGINE SHALL NOT BE USED AS PART OF AN INTERRUPTIBLE SERVICE CONTRACT IN WHICH A FACILITY RECEIVES A PAYMENT OR REDUCED RATES IN RETURN FOR REDUCING ELECTRIC LOAD ON THE GRID WHEN REQUESTED TO DO SO BY THE UTILITY OR THE GRID OPERATOR.
- 6. AN OPERATIONAL NON-RESETTABLE ELAPSED TIME METER SHALL BE INSTALLED AND MAINTAINED TO INDICATE THE ENGINE ELAPSED OPERATING TIME.

- 7. AN ENGINE OPERATING LOG SHALL BE MAINTAINED TO RECORD WHEN THIS ENGINE IS STARTED MANUALLY. THE LOG SHALL LIST THE DATE OF OPERATION, THE TIMER READING IN HOURS AT THE BEGINNING AND END OF OPERATION AND THE REASON FOR OPERATION. IN ADDITION, ON A MONTHLY BASIS THE LOG SHALL LIST ALL ENGINE OPERATION IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS:
  - A. EMERGENCY USE HOURS OF OPERATION
  - B. MAINTENANCE AND TESTING HOURS
  - C. OTHER OPERATING HOURS (DESCRIBE THE REASON FOR OPERATION)

THE LOG SHALL BE KEPT FOR A MINIMUM OF THREE CALENDAR YEARS PRIOR TO THE CURRENT YEAR AND MADE AVAILABLE TO DISTRICT PERSONNEL UPON REQUEST. THE TOTAL HOURS OF OPERATION FOR THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR SHALL BE RECORDED SOMETIME DURING THE FIRST 15 DAYS OF JANUARY OF EACH YEAR.

- 8. THE OPERATOR SHALL NOT PURCHASE ANY DIESEL FUEL UNLESS THE FUEL IS LOW SULFUR DIESEL FOR WHICH THE SULFUR CONTENT DOES NOT EXCEED 15 PPM BY WEIGHT. AS OF JANUARY 1, 2006, THE OPERATOR SHALL ONLY USE DIESEL FUEL WITH A SULFUR CONTENT THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 15 PPM BY WEIGHT, UNLESS THE OPERATOR DEMONSTRATES IN WRITING TO THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER THAT SPECIFIC ADDITIONAL TIME IS NECESSARY.
