1 **STIPULATION**

2 Respondent Baker Commodities, Inc. ("Baker") and Petitioner South Coast Air Quality
3 Management District (the "District") (collectively Baker and the District shall be referred to as
4 "Parties") hereby agree and stipulate, as follows:

5 WHEREAS, Baker's Request to Modify the Order of Abatement will be heard on Tuesday,
6 December 13, 2022 before the South Coast Air Quality Management District Hearing Board;

7 WHEREAS, Baker's opening brief in support of its Request to Modify the Order of
8 Abatement was filed and served on November 29, 2022;

9 WHEREAS, the District claims Baker has filed its opening brief past the deadline set forth
10 in Hearing Board Rule 5(d)(2), and Baker disagrees;

11 WHEREAS, a controversy has, therefore, arisen regarding the briefing schedule, which
12 absent this stipulation and the entry of the proposed order, would require the Parties to engage in
13 motion practice;

14 WHEREAS, the Parties prefer to stipulate to the briefing schedule herein to conserve party
15 resources and the Hearing Board's resource; and

16 WHEREAS, the Parties have met and conferred in good faith regarding the briefing
17 schedule for Baker's Request to Modify the Order of Abatement for the Hearing Board's
18 consideration pursuant to Hearing Board Rule 5(d)(2);

19 NOW THEREFORE, the Parties stipulate to the following briefing schedule:

20 1. The District's opposition to Baker's opening brief in support of its Request to
21 Modify the Order of Abatement shall be filed and served by no later than Wednesday, December
22 7, 2022; and

23 2. Baker's reply to the District's opposition to Baker's opening brief in support of its
24 Request to Modify the Order of Abatement shall be filed and served by no later than Thursday,
25 December 8, 2022.




