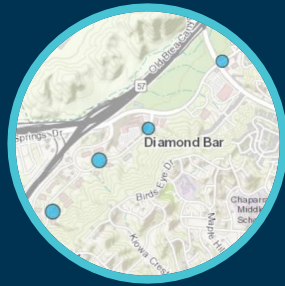

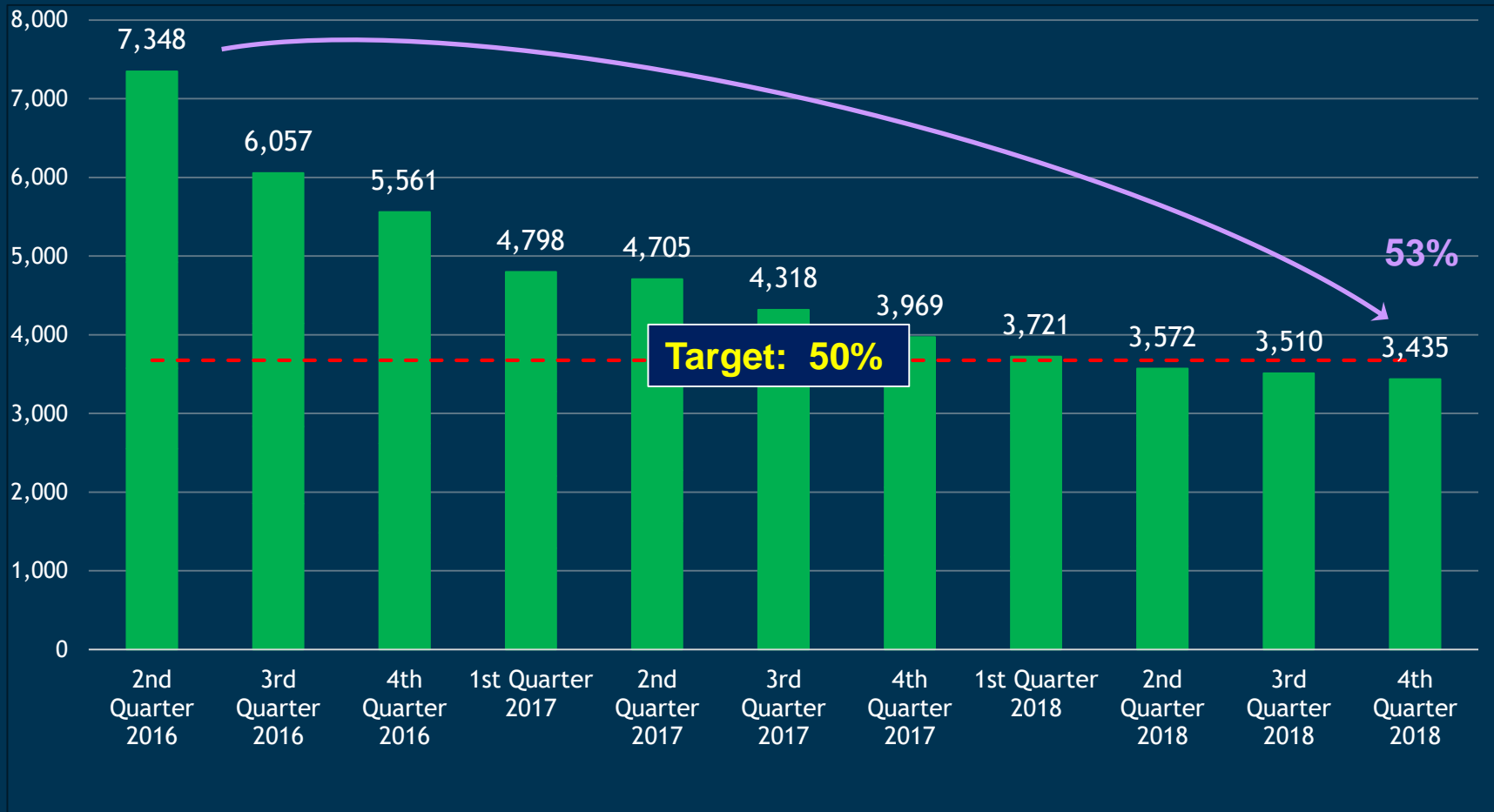

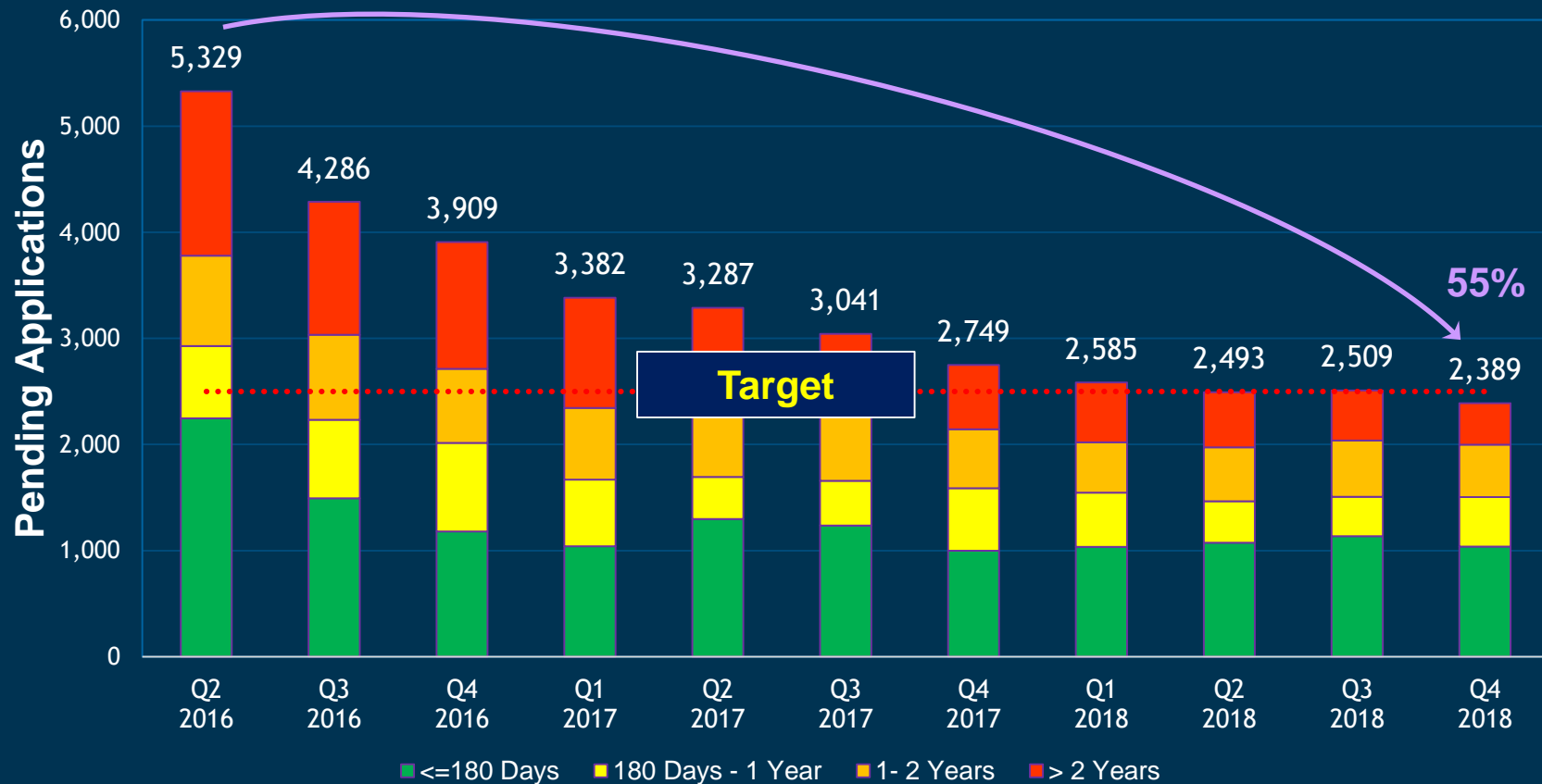

# Recent E&P Policies and Procedures

- BACT Guidelines (06-07-18)
- Streamlined Permit Issuance (06-14-18)
- Public Notice Implementation Guideline (01-31-19)
- Equivalent Catalyst Replacement (02-05-19)

# Recent E&P Policies and Procedures (cont.)

## BACT Guidelines

- Recommends a contemporaneous five year period to evaluate emission increases
- BACT requirements triggered for contemporaneous emission increases exceeding one pound per day

## Streamlined Permit Issuance Guidelines

- Encourages issuance of PC/PO or PO for new construction
- Sets source testing requirements
- Standardizes permit conditions for source testing
- Does not apply to high profile projects, toxics, BACT/NSR determinations

# Recent E&P Policies and Procedures (cont.)

## Public Notice Guideline

- Rule 212 (c)(1) requires public notice for permit applications near schools
- H&SC 42301.6 excludes applications that will result in a reduction or equivalent amount of air contaminants
- Guideline identifies what is considered equivalent
  - Less than one pound per day
  - Less than an order of magnitude less than thresholds triggered by Rule 1401

## Catalyst Equivalency Procedure

- Supports permit conditions that allow for replacing catalyst without requiring permit modification
- Specifies standardized criteria and permit conditions for demonstrating equivalency, including testing and pre-approval requirements
