



What is hydrogen sulfide (H₂S)?

- H₂S is a gas with a strong odor, similar to rotten eggs.
- H₂S may cause symptoms such as headaches and nausea, and/or respiratory and nasal irritation
- H₂S occur from natural processes in the Salton Sea.
