Thus, we have a vested interest in seeing this area has a solid quality of life and continues to thrive.

Furthermore, our members have developed a strong working knowledge of the needs, concerns, importance, and potential of this community. The remaining challenges to be addressed will require solid technical and scientific expertise to create an inclusive, effective Community Emissions Reduction Plan (CERP). NAIOP IE members cover a broad range of expertise from environmental analyses and mitigation measures, to land use planning, to creating collaborative approaches to complex issues, among other areas. Thus, we can bring numerous resources to this important effort without having to create a Community Steering Committee that is too large to accomplish its goals.
