Background



- **Funding Agricultural Replacement Measures for Emission Reductions (FARMER)**
- **Additional statewide funds to reduce Ag emissions**
 - SCAQMD = over \$1.8 million in additional funds

- **Comply with Carl Moyer Program guidelines**
 - Application, calculations, project criteria
- **Prioritizes funding in disadvantaged communities and low-income households**

Project Types



Replacement

- Purchase of new or used equipment with an engine certified to the current emission standard (Tier 4 Final), or zero emission technology, to replace an older, fully functional equipment that is to be scrapped.

Repower

- The replacement of an existing engine with newer emission-certified engine, or zero-emission system, instead of rebuilding the existing engine to its original specifications.

Retrofit

- Installation of a CARB-verified diesel emission control system on an existing engine (e.g., diesel particulate filter and diesel oxidation catalyst).

Reporting/Recordkeeping



- **Annual Reports:**
 - Reports are for the term of contract
 - Carl Moyer Program reporting requirements
 - Operational Usage data (hour meter reading)
