Background

Funding Agricultural Replacement Measures for Emission Reductions (FARMER) Program



- ▶ FARMER Program funding is available to help fund purchases of cleaner agriculture-related equipment
- ▶ Reduce emissions from the agricultural sector, yielding positive health impacts for farmers and their communities
- ▶ Prioritize funding to disadvantaged communities



*Rounded value includes project funding and implementation costs

- FARMER Program supports zero-emission UTV projects and may not require a case-by-case evaluation by ARB

Program Criteria



At least 50% of annual activity is performing agricultural operations



Comply with Carl Moyer Program Guidelines



Apply for FARMER funds using the Carl Moyer Program Online Application System (or by paper submittal)



Must own equipment for duration of contract



Must submit 3 to 10 years of annual reports (for the life of the project/contract term)
