- Prioritize funding to disadvantaged communities






Types of Projects funded under FARMER











• FARMER Program supports zero-emission UTV projects and may not require a caseby-case evaluation by ARB





At least 50% of annual activity is performing agricultural operations





Comply with Carl Moyer Program Guidelines



Apply for FARMER funds using the Carl Moyer Program Online Application System (or by paper submittal)



Must own equipment for duration of contract



Must submit 3 to 10 years of annual reports (for the life of the project/contract term)
