Background



- **Funding Agricultural Replacement Measures for Emission Reductions (FARMER)**
- **Additional statewide funds to reduce Ag emissions**
 - SCAQMD = over \$1.7 million in additional funds
- **Comply with Carl Moyer Program guidelines**
 - Application, calculations, project criteria
- **Prioritizes funding in disadvantaged communities and low-income households**

Eligible Projects



- **Equipment types:**
 - Ag harvesting equipment
 - HD trucks
 - Ag pump engines
 - Tractors
 - Other equipment used in Ag operations
- **Project types:**
 - Replacement/repower (same as CMP)
 - Zero-emission Ag utility terrain vehicle (UTV) project

Reporting/Recordkeeping



- **Reports for term of contract:**
 - Carl Moyer Program reporting requirements
 - Fuel consumption and usage data.
