## <u>Draft Environmental Impact Report (Draft EIR) for the</u> <u>Proposed Santa Monica Land Use and Circulation Element (LUCE)</u>

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) appreciates the opportunity to comment on the above-mentioned document. The following comments are meant as guidance for the lead agency and should be incorporated into the Final EIR.

SCAQMD staff is pleased to note the incorporation of mitigation measures MM4.2-1 and MM4.2-2 that address potentially significant air quality impacts. The lead agency's inclusion of recommendations from the California Air Resources Board Land Use Handbook into its Municipal Code will substantially reduce the exposure of sensitive receptors to major sources of toxic air contaminants for future projects.

As determined by the lead agency, construction related air quality impacts remain significant and unavoidable because project specific calculations are infeasible at this time. SCAQMD staff therefore recommends that the lead agency contact SCAQMD through the CEQA process for individual projects as they develop. Project specific mitigation measures, including potential use of the cleanest burning construction equipment available, may reduce this impact to a less than significant level for each individual future project.
