The Annual Air Quality Monitoring Network Plan describes the network of ambient air quality monitors located within the South Coast AQMD's four county jurisdiction. The Plan includes a review of actions taken during the previous fiscal year, and outlines plans for action in the year ahead.

Federal regulations require that the air quality monitoring network be reviewed annually to identify any need for additions, relocations, or terminations of monitoring sites or instrumentation. After a 30-day comment period, the Plan is submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) on July 1 of each year.
