SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS ALISO CANYON FACILITY PROPOSED TITLE V PERMIT RENEWAL

South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has received a request for a Title V Permit renewal from the Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) for the Aliso Canyon natural gas storage facility (Aliso Canyon). Title V Permits are required by the federal Clean Air Act for facilities that emit air pollutants above certain levels and are subject to renewal every five years.

South Coast AQMD has received public comments on the proposed renewal of the Title V Permit for SoCalGas Aliso Canyon. The agency is holding a public information meeting to provide an update on the proposed permit renewal, comments received and discuss next steps. Please note that the focus of this public information meeting will be on the federal Title V permit, therefore discussions will be limited to the permitting program only.
