Proposed Amended Rule 1113 – Architectural Coatings

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO
THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF
THE SOUTH COAST AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
AND PROPOSED SUBMISSION INTO THE STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing on the matter of adoption of rules and regulations for the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD), or the amendments thereto, will be held on Friday, December 4, 2015 in the Auditorium at SCAQMD Headquarters, 21865 Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, CA 91765, at 9:00 a.m., at which time evidence will be taken and all interested persons will be heard by the SCAQMD Board.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the SCAQMD is considering the adoption of Proposed Amended Rule 1113 – Architectural Coatings. The proposed amended rule will restrict the small container exemption for some categories, lower some VOC limits, change some coating categories, revise definitions, include new coating categories, include new test methods to support the new coating categories, include two new VOC test methods, and clarify rule language. The proposed amendments will reduce volatile organic compound emissions by approximately 1 ton per day by implementing portions of Control Measure CTS-01 from the 2012 Air Quality Implementation Plan.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the proposed amendments to Rule 1113 – Architectural Coatings will be submitted to the California Air Resources Board and the United States Environmental Protection Agency for inclusion into the State Implementation Plan.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the proposed amendments to Rule 1113 – Architectural Coatings implement Sections 110, 172, 183(e), and 189 of the Clean Air Act.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a written analysis pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 40727.2 has been prepared and is part of the staff report which is available as specified below.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the SCAQMD staff has prepared documents, for consideration by the SCAQMD Board, including:
