



Additionally, there are labeling requirements for date codes on architectural coating containers, found in section (d)(1):

Containers for all coatings subject to this rule shall display the date of manufacture of the contents or a code indicating the date of manufacture. The manufacturers of such coatings shall file with the Executive Officer of the District and the Executive Officer of the Air Resources Board an explanation of each code.

The following exemption is in section (f)(2)

The provisions of subparagraph (d)(1) through (d)(7) shall not apply to architectural coatings in containers having capacities of two fluid ounces (59mL) or less.

**Analysis:**

VOC content and date codes must be included on the coating label or container for any architectural coating having a capacity greater than two fluid ounces. After January 1, 2014, VOCs must be in specific format.
