Warehouse Owners - Rule 2305 Upcoming Compliance Due Dates and Obligations

Due Date	Report
September 1, 2021*	Warehouse owners to submit Warehouse Operations Notification[^] <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Owner contact information and whether they are an operator Warehouse information: address and building size Tenant information: contact information and lease start and end dates

* Or Within 14 days of operator change or 30 days after renovation that changes the square footage

[^] Warehouse Operations Notification is the only required reporting obligation for warehouse owners under Rule 2305

Warehouse Operators - Rule 2305 Upcoming Compliance Due Dates and Obligations

Due Date	Report/Obligation*
January 31, 2022	Optional Annual WAIRE Reports (AWR) for Early Action <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Document early voluntary implementation of WAIRE Menu actions taken in 2021 since rule adoption AWR must be filed by January 31, 2022 to bank Points for future compliance periods
January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022	First compliance period for operators with warehouses \geq 250,000 square feet <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Earn WAIRE points AWR must be submitted by January 31, 2023
July 1, 2022	Operators with warehouses \geq 250,000 square feet to submit Initial Site Information Report <ul style="list-style-type: none"> From July 2021, operators must begin collecting 12 months of truck trip data (i.e. between July 2021 and June 2022)

*If the warehouse operator vacates the warehouse during the compliance period, the AWR is due the date the operator leaves
