The license shall expire if the license renewal fee is not received by the District, postmarked, or electronically paid within 30 days after invoices are sent by mail, electronic mail, or other electronic means or June 30<sup>th</sup>, whichever is later.

(3) A CPP license that has expired due to nonpayment of the annual renewal fee may be reinstated by submitting a request for reinstatement and payment in full of the amount due at the time the license expired. A reinstatement surcharge shall also be paid equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the amount due. Such request and payment shall be made within six (6) months of the license expiration. A license shall not be reinstateable after December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year it has expired.
