# **Purpose of This Meeting**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled a public workshop for the purpose of soliciting information and suggestions from the public on Proposed Amended Rule 1405 – Control Of Ethylene Oxide Emissions From Sterilization and Related Operations (PAR 1405). PAR 1405 is scheduled for a Public Hearing before the South Coast AQMD Governing Board on June 2, 2023 (subject to change).

### Background

Sterilization and fumigation processes using ethylene oxide (EtO) are regulated under Rule 1405. During South Coast AQMD's monitoring efforts at several commercial sterilization facilities in 2022, the agency became aware of fugitive emissions from sources that were not previously identified at elevated levels of concentration. PAR 1405 is being developed to address EtO emissions from sterilization processes and related operations.

# **Proposed Amended Rule and Objectives**

PAR 1405 includes new and enhanced control and monitoring requirements to further reduce both stack and fugitive EtO emissions from sterilization operations, as well as other provisions such as reporting, recordkeeping and source testing. PAR 1405 also includes requirements such as labeling and inventory provisions for certain large warehouses and designated warehouses receiving EtO-sterilized materials.

# **California Environmental Quality Act**

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and South Coast AQMD's certified regulatory program (Public Resources Code Section 21080.5, CEQA Guidelines Section 15251(1) and South Coast AQMD Rule 110), the South Coast AQMD, as lead agency for the proposed project, will prepare the appropriate CEQA documentation for the proposed project in accordance with CEQA requirements.
