Purpose of This Meeting

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled a Public Workshop to present and solicit information and suggestions from the public regarding Proposed Amended Rule 1168 – Adhesive and Sealant Applications (PAR 1168) which is scheduled for a Public Hearing before the South Coast AQMD Governing Board on November 4, 2022 (subject to change).

Rule Background

Rule 1168 was adopted in April 1989 to reduce emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOCs), toxic air contaminants, and stratospheric ozone-depleting compounds from the application of adhesives, adhesive primers, sealants, and sealant primers and applies to any person who uses, sells, stores, supplies, distributes, offers for sale, or manufactures for sale any adhesives, adhesive primers, sealants, and sealant primers. Rule 1168 has been amended 14 times, the last amendment was in October 2017 which included VOC limit reductions for 18 categories, new Quantity and Emissions Reporting (QER) requirements, and a requirement for staff to conduct a technical assessment to assess the feasibility of certain VOC limits that will be effective on January 1, 2023.

Objective of Proposed Amended Rule

The objective of PAR 1168 is to delay the effective date for certain categories where the technology assessment has demonstrated more time would be needed; create further subcategories to better characterize and refine VOC limits; prohibit the use of Para-Chlorobenzotrifluoride (pCBtF) and Tertiary-Butyl Acetate (t-BAc); and allow certain categories to maintain higher VOC limits due to the prohibition on pCBtF and t-BAc or because a newly created subcategory of adhesive or sealant requires a higher VOC limit. This proposal does not change the reporting requirements for manufacturers and private labelers or sell through provisions.

California Environmental Quality Act

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and South Coast AQMD's certified regulatory program (Public Resources Code Section 21080.5, CEQA Guidelines Section 15251(l) and South Coast AQMD Rule 110), the South Coast AQMD, as lead agency, is reviewing the proposed project (PAR 1168) to determine

if it will result in any potential adverse environmental impacts. Appropriate CEOA documentation will be prepared based on the analysis.
