

PROPOSED RULE 120. CREDIBLE EVIDENCE

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision in the State Implementation Plan approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) or any rule adopted by the SCAQMD, any credible evidence may be used to establish whether a person has violated or is in violation of any plan, order, permit, rule, regulation, or law.
- (b) Testing, monitoring, or other information-gathering methods that are approved or specified by the SCAQMD, California Air Resources Board, or the U.S. EPA, presumptively yield credible evidence.
