<u>Background</u>

- > 2007 Air Quality Management Plan
 - AQMP control measure EGM-01 to mitigate emission increases resulting from development and redevelopment projects

Proposed Rule Overview

<u>Background</u>

- AQMD required by law to consider all feasible measures
 - Colusa County APCD
 - Great Basin Unified APCD
 - Imperial County APCD
 - Mendocino County AQMD
 - Placer County APCD
 - Sacramento Metropolitan AQMD (in development)
 - San Joaquin Valley APCD
 - Shasta County AQMD

Proposed Rule Overview (cont.)

<u>Background</u>

- EGM-01 Emission Reduction Goals for 2023
 - NOx 0.8 tpd
 - VOC 0.5 tpd
 - PM2.5 0.5 tpd

Proposed Rule 2301

<u>Purpose</u>

Reduce emission from growth in residential, commercial, industrial and institutional projects

Applicability

Development projects with an operational NOx emissions of 2 tons/year or more and is required to prepare an EIR, ND, or MND

Construction Phase

- Demonstrate compliance with CARB In-Use Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation
- Use architectural coatings that do not exceed 50% of the VOC limits in Rule 1113 or use one of the following at project site:
 - Certified Clean Air Choices cleaning products
 - CARB certified leaf blowers

Operational Phase

- Area source emissions reductions equivalent to X% beyond Title 24 energy standards
- Transportation emissions implement transportation emission reduction strategies (menu of options)
- > Allow for substitute measures

Delegation to Local Governments

- AQMD may delegate authority to any local governments that choose to:
 - Adopt the rule provisions by ordinance or
 - Adopt a local plan that will achieve equivalent emission reductions


Exemptions

- Transportation and transit projects
- Reconstruction to same use and intensity
- Published NOP prior to rule adoption
- Projects at marine ports and airports

Compliance Schedule

- > January 1, 2010 − 10 tons/year NOx or greater
- January 1, 2011 − 4 tons/year or greater
- → January 1, 2012 2 tons/year or greater
