Proposed Rule Background

2007 Air Quality Management Plan

- The AQMP calls for EGM-01 to reduce growth emissions from development projects
- PR 2301 is designed to implement EGM-01 by reducing emissions from residential, commercial, industrial and institutional projects

Proposed Rule Overview (cont.)

Purpose

Reduce emissions from growth in residential, commercial, industrial and institutional development

Applicability

Development projects with an overall NOx emissions of 2.0 tpy or greater and is required to prepare an EIR, ND or MND

Compliance Plan Requirements

- A. A compliance plan must be submitted 20 days prior to public notification required by CEQA
- B. The compliance plan must include:
 - Contact information
 - Project description and emissions
 - Emission reduction strategies

Emission Reduction Requirements

Construction Phase Requirements

- 1. Comply with CARB's In-Use Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation, and
- 2. Use architectural coatings that do not exceed 50% of the VOC limits in SCAQMD Rule 1113 or
- 3. On-site operational practices

Emission Reduction Requirements (cont.)

Operational Phase Requirements

Implement one of the following strategies:

Emissions Threshold (tons per year)	Emission Reduction Strategies (PR 2301Guidance Documents)
2.0 or greater	Emission Reduction Strategy 1
4.0 or greater	Emission Reduction Strategy 2
10.0 or greater	Emission Reduction Strategy 3

Delegation to Local Government

SCAQMD may delegate authority to any local government that chooses to:

- Adopt by ordinance the rule provisions <u>or</u> a program that will attain the same reductions
- Set-forth the rule requirements in a local plan or achieves at least the same overall reductions, and
- Meets set performance standards

Proposed Rule Implementation

Compliance Schedule

Implementation Date	Annual Operational Emissions (tons per years)
January 1, 2010	8 or greater
January 1, 2011	4 or greater
January 1, 2012	2 or greater

Proposed Rule Implementation (cont.)

Compliance Plan Review Process

- Application status provided 20 days from receipt of the Plan
- AQMD will notify the applicant if any additional Plan information is required.
- AQMD will notify the applicant of approval /disapproval 30 days after the Plan is deemed complete.
- Any project changes that increase emissions will require submission of a new Plan

Proposed Rule Implementation (cont.)

Fees

Fees will be assessed in accordance with Rule 306

Exemptions

- Transportation and transit projects,
- Projects with operational emissions less than 2.0 tpy of NOx
- Reconstruction of any project damaged or destroyed and rebuilt to the same use and intensity,
- Projects that have commenced an environmental analysis through a lead agency on or before rule adoption, and
- Projects at marine ports
