



- □ Staff presented background for Proposed Rule 2306 (PR 2306) rulemaking
- ☐ Highlighted two proposed new intermodal facilities within the South Coast AQMD jurisdiction
- □ Discussed the following topics:
 - Limitations of CEQA
 - Concerns with local impacts to nearby Environmental Justice communities
 - Federal ambient air quality standards and general conformity
 - Potential emission sources at new intermodal facilities
