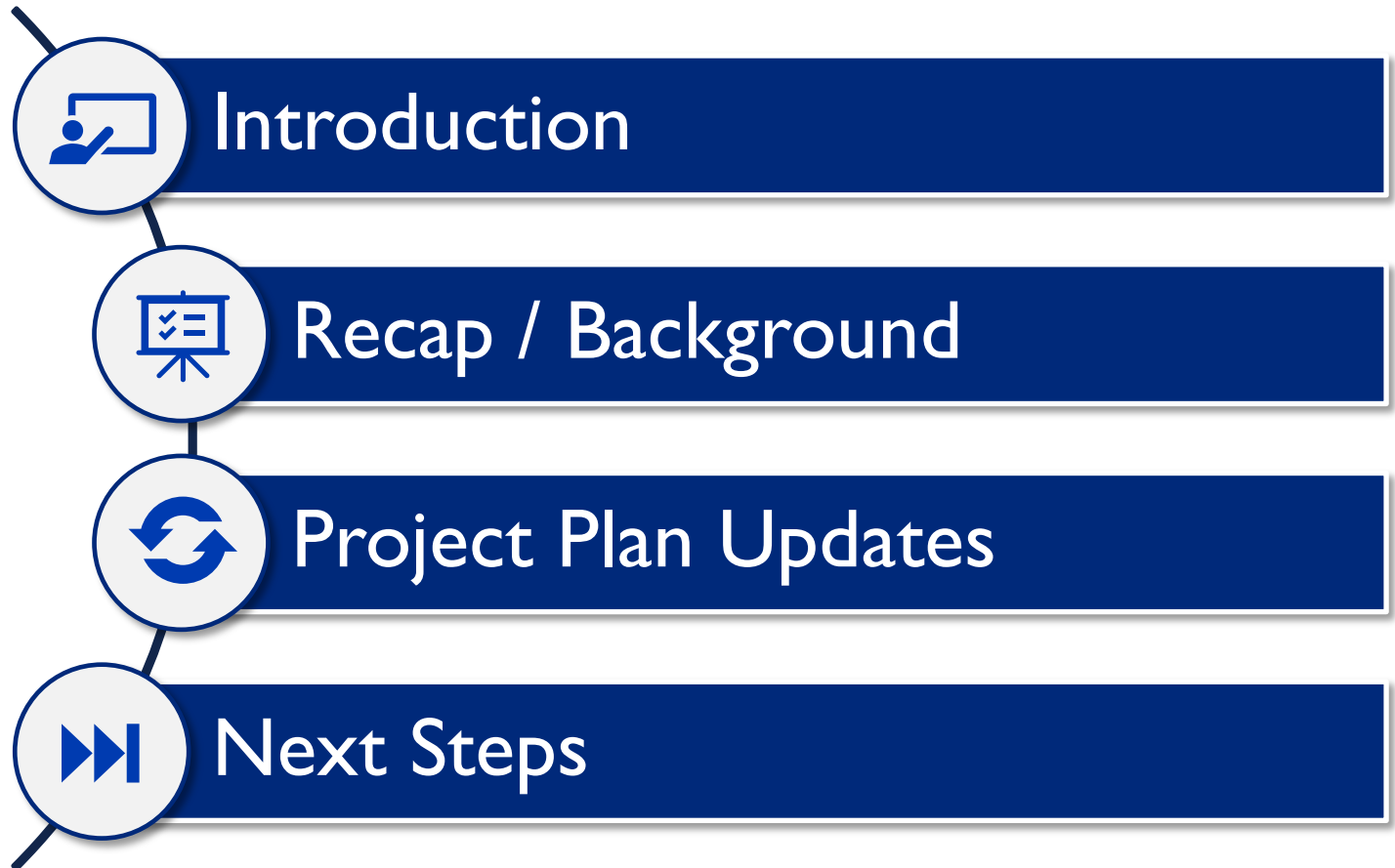

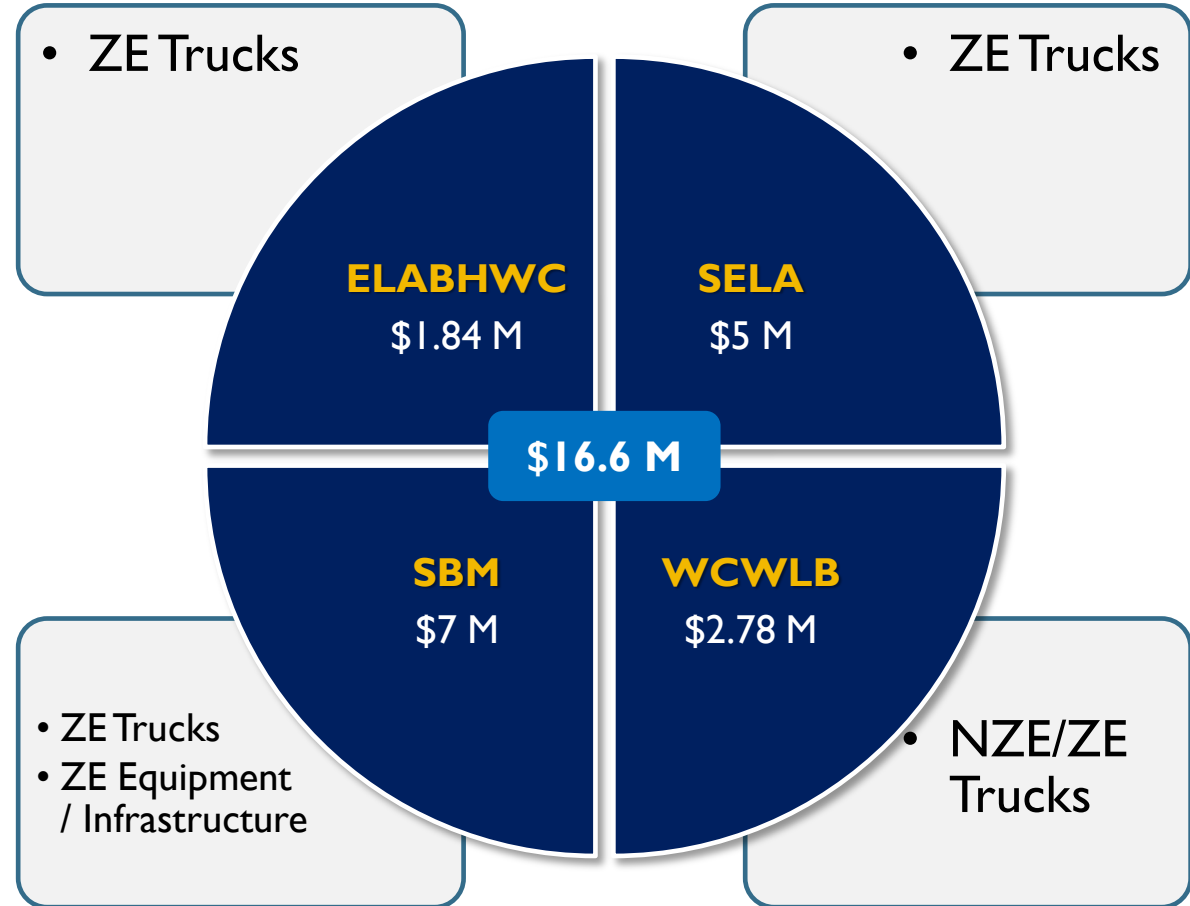

RECAP / BACKGROUND

AB 617 Truck Incentives

- CERP's actions focus on reducing truck emissions
- Year 1 and 2 AB 617 Communities requested improved access to clean truck incentives
- Communities prioritized \$16.6 M for these incentives

Project Plan

Purpose

- Opportunity for AB 617 Communities to test out zero-emission trucks without committing to a full-scale purchase
- Mechanism to develop incentive program to fund zero-emission trucks

Process

- Plan developed with community input/feedback
- Requires CARB approval before program can be implemented

PROJECT PLAN UPDATES **OVERVIEW**

Prioritizes Zero-Emission Technology

- Limits plan to ZE projects
- Community support for prioritizing ZE projects evident in funding allocations

Focus on Truck Loaner Program

- Allows for increased participation with limited funding
- Transitions residual funds to traditional incentives

Specifies Eligible Funding Criteria

- Incorporates max. funding amounts for applicants by percentage
- Identifies covered costs for applicants and vendors

PROJECT PLAN UPDATES *ZERO-EMISSION TRUCKS*

Prioritizing Zero-Emission Trucks

Zero-Emission truck technologies identified as community priority to replace diesel trucks

Support for technology is present but turnover is slow due to costs, driving range, infrastructure, and others

Loaner concept to help the fill gap between operating diesel trucks and fully purchasing zero-emission technologies

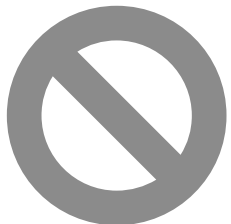
Truck Loaner Concept



Owners/operators of an existing truck can apply to rent a zero-emission truck for a set amount of time through a third-party vendor



Owner/operators will need to demonstrate operation within an approved AB 617 community



During the loan period, existing truck must not be in service

PROJECT PLAN UPDATES FUNDING

Eligible Funding Criteria

Applicants

Up to 100% of project fees covered for:

- Renting/Leasing
- Fees/Taxes
- Insurance
- Maintenance
- Charging/Fueling
- Delivery
- Training/Education

Vendor

Updated administrative cost limits for program implementation

RFP/PA

Determine eligible and non-eligible costs and other criteria through a public process

RFP/PA

- Request for Proposal (RFP) and Program Announcement (PA) will be developed through a public process

Focus Group

- Gather interested parties to form focus group
- Receive input/feedback for RFP/PA

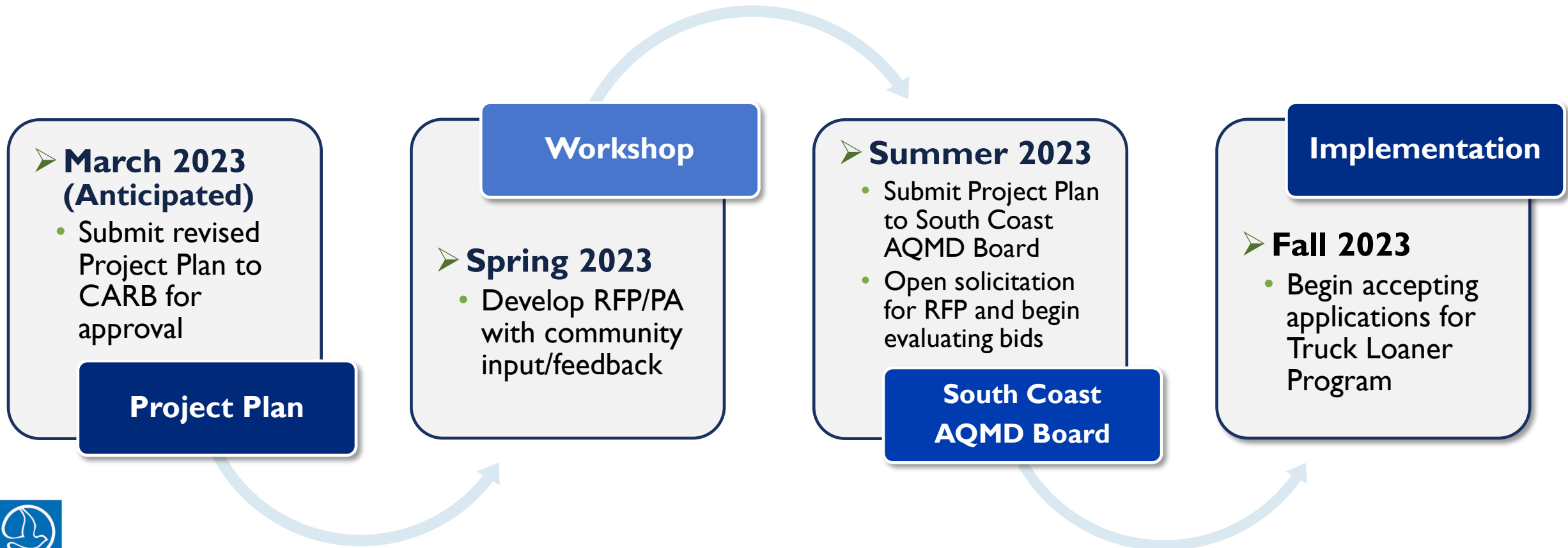
Focus Group Input/Feedback

- Vendor:
 - Determine eligible administrative funding levels
 - Review other program parameters and requirements
- Applicant:
 - Lease/Rental duration
 - Maximum funding per project unit
 - Project selection methodology
 - Other applicable metrics
