 - \$5,000 per light-duty vehicle
 - \$20,000 per commercial vehicle




• Who and How is the Project funded?

- California Air Resources Board via Increases in Fees:
 - Smog Abatement, Vehicle Registration, and Vessel Registration
- When did the Project start?
 - Program launched March 15, 2010







Who is Eligible?

5

- Individual, business, nonprofit or government entity <u>based in</u>
 California or <u>has a California based affiliate</u>
- Purchase or Lease a <u>NEW</u> Zero-Emission Vehicle (ZEV) or Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicle (PHEV)
- Vehicle must be purchased **AFTER** March 15, 2010
- MUST own/lease the vehicle for a MINIMUM of 36 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS
 - MUST be registered with the California DMV for a MINIMUM of 36 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS

Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicles

Light Duty Zero Emission Vehicles

- Rebate amount <u>based on two factors</u>:
 - Vehicle Range and Fast Refueling Capability
 - Vehicles categorized from Type I to Type V

Type I.5



Smart ED

- Eligible for \$4,000
- ≥75, <100 miles
- Fast refueling capability does not apply

Type II, III, IV and V



Nissan LEAF (II)

- •All Eligible for \$5,000
- •≥100 miles
- Fast refueling dependent on vehicle type



How do I apply?

Step 1

- Go to www.energycenter.org/cvrp
- Select vehicle and fill out application

Step 2

- Email sent with applications and information
- Mail in supporting documents
 - Within 14 calendar days



Supporting Documents



Proof of temporary or permanent vehicle registration



Copy of the sales or lease contract signed by all parties Itemized list of credits, discounts and incentives received



<u>Individuals:</u> Proof of California Residency including a **utility or cable bill** from within the last 3 MONTHS or a notarized rental agreement

NOTE A California driver license is not an acceptable proof of residency



<u>Business/Nonprofits:</u> Copy of formation document filed with the CA Secretary of State. Sole proprietors may submit a copy of a utility or cable bill from within the last 3 months, or a current vehicle DMV registration or notarized rental agreement.





California: Clean Vehicle Rebate Project -\$1,000-\$20,000 depending on zero emissions vehicle type

Bay Area Air Quality Management District
- \$5 million in EV infrastructure

San Joaquin Valley Remove II Program
-\$1,000-\$3,000 depending on vehicle
emissions

City of Riverside Alternative Fuels Rebate
- Up to \$2,000 depending on MPG



Are there additional incentives?

- Federal Vehicle Tax Credit
 - Range from \$2,500 to \$7,500.
- To qualify:
 - Battery capacity of at least 4 kilowatt-hours
 - Additional \$417 of credit per kWh above 5 kWh
- Federal Infrastructure Tax Credit
 - Electric Vehicle charging stations
 - Homes: 50% of costs up to a maximum of \$2000
 - Businesses: Up to \$50,000 per business site




















Required supporting documentation will include, at a minimum, the following:

- A printed copy of the submitted application signed by the vehicle purchaser, lessee or authorized representative.
- Proof of temporary or permanent vehicle registration.

TESLA Requirements - Windows Internet Explorer

- A copy of the sales or lease contract signed by all parties with an itemization of credits, discounts and incentives received, if applicable.
- For individuals, a copy of a utility or cable bill from within the last 3 months or other valid proof of California residency as approved by the California Center for Sustainable Energy.
 forms of valid proof include a signed, dated and notarized rental agreement or a copy of a current vehicle DMV registration. A California driver license is not an acceptable proof or residency.
- For a business or nonprofit, a copy of the formation document filed with the California Secretary of State or other documentation as approved by the California Center for Sustaina Energy. Sole proprietors may submit a copy of a utility or cable bill from within the last 3 months, a current vehicle DMV registration or a notarized rental agreement.
- For ZEMs and NEVs, as identified on the vehicle eligibility list, evidence of sealed maintenance-free batteries and a 24-month warranty.

Resale of a vehicle or return to a dealership is allowed within the required 36-month period if necessitated by unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances and as approved by the Air Resources Board. Rebate recipients who do not receive ARB approval for resales or returns will be required to reimburse the ARB all or part of the original rebate amount.
