



## **SOUTH COAST AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT**

Dear Salvage Yard Operator:

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) Proposition 1B Program requires destruction of replaced trucks at qualified salvage yards to ensure that these older, high emitting vehicles are removed from service. Qualified salvage yards must be licensed by the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) as a vehicle dismantler, have a current, valid California Environmental Protection Agency (Cal/EPA) Hazardous Materials Generators Permit, and be in compliance with all local, state and federal laws and regulations. Salvage yards must sign and return this form to AQMD in order to participate in AQMD's Proposition 1B Program.

Once the old truck is delivered, the AQMD-approved dismantler must do all of the following:

- Check the old truck to verify it is in operable working condition (Not necessary if the truck was delivered under its own power.)
- Upon receipt of the old truck, complete, sign and return the “top portion” of Attachment 3 to the AQMD. This is required to verify the date of acceptance by the dismantler.
- Dismantle the old truck within sixty (60) days of receipt as follows:
  - ✓ Destroy and render useless the old truck's engine by cutting a six inch by six inch hole in the engine block.
  - ✓ Cut the frame rails of the old truck to ensure that the truck will not be used again.
- The AQMD may approve an extension of an additional 15 days for a total of 75 days to destroy the old truck if the dismantler notifies the AQMD in writing that the number of trucks received is beyond their capacity and they cannot meet the 60-day requirement to destroy the old truck. The written request must include the period of time that is needed to destroy the truck and approximately how many trucks will be affected.
- Within 10 calendar days of the destruction of the vehicle, the following documents shall be submitted to the AQMD at the address below:
  - 1) Digital photographs on a CD with a label description identifying each photograph including the following:
    - Engine tag with serial number, engine family number, and engine model year.

- Destroyed engine block either inside or outside truck body (note that salvage of engine parts is strictly prohibited).
  - Vehicle Identification Number printed by manufacturer inside cab.
  - Truck view from front angle capturing entire truck with readable license plate.
  - Side truck view showing the severed frame rails.
- 2) A fully completed Attachment 3 (AQMD Certificate of Replaced Vehicle Receipt and Destruction) which must be signed by an authorized salvage yard representative. All fields in Attachment 3 must be completed.
- 3) A copy of the DMV REG 42 Form “Notice to Dismantler” or REG 488C Form “Non-Repairable Vehicle Certificate” as submitted to the DMV. The box entitled “Dismantled Do Not Register” on the REG 42 Form must be checked.

Note that funding is not available under this Program for any salvage or material disposal costs, including hazardous waste abatement fees, labor costs, fines, permits or other charges resulting from the destruction or disposal of the vehicles. AQMD is not responsible for any costs associated with the destruction of the vehicles under this Program.

Failure to meet your obligations in this agreement may, among other legal remedies, result in your disqualification from participation in AQMD’s Proposition 1B Program.
