The California Fuel Cell Partnership (CaFCP) is seeking a regional coordinator to be CaFCP's representative for general program support, technical assistance, communications, outreach and special events in the greater Los Angeles region. This position will also be CaFCP's government relations main point of contact. **This position is located in Diamond Bar, California.**

The CaFCP is a unique collaborative of auto manufacturers, energy companies, fuel cell technology companies, and government agencies that is advancing fuel cell vehicle and fueling technology. The CaFCP members are placing fuel cell vehicles and fueling into real-world testing applications, facilitating the path to commercialization and increasing public awareness of this new technology.

Responsibilities: The regional coordinator will be responsible for staffing CaFCP's Southern California office, located at the South Coast Air Quality Management District in Diamond Bar, California. This position will act as the CaFCP's main contact for government relations, monitoring and reporting on federal, state and local initiatives regarding hydrogen and fuel cells. The regional coordinator will provide support to CaFCP members' projects located in Southern California, including developing and maintaining contacts with fleet demonstration programs, tracking metrics, and supporting the program specialist, safety specialist and communications staff in technical and general community outreach projects for Southern California. This position will conduct outreach in the greater Los Angeles region, including managing tour and other outreach requests for the Southern California area, making written and oral presentations to local communities, media, general public and interested stakeholders, and organizing and carrying out community-scale events. The position requires frequent travel within the Southern California area, and occasional travel to Northern California and other locations.

Qualifications: The successful applicant will have a Bachelor's degree in a science or environmental field, and will demonstrate practical, on the job experience in technical and environmental programs, government relations, technical outreach and communications.

Required Skills: Strong analytical and problem solving skills; ability to write well for both technical and general public audiences; strong presentation skills; general understanding of fuel cell vehicles and hydrogen; public speaking experience; ability to work independently as well as in a small team environment.
