Mr. Bullard is the maintenance supervisor for Channel Islands National Park. He has worked in his present position since March 1982. During his tenure he has been responsible for the installation of 64 photovoltaic systems and implementation of other sustainable practices, including use of CNG vehicles, re-refined motor oils, recycled building materials, water and energy conservation programs and the use of biodiesel.

He founded the Southern California Biodiesel Users Group and co-founded the Los Angeles Biodiesel Coop. Additionally he works as an auditor for the National Biodiesel BQ-9000 Accreditation Program.

His work in promoting and implementing sustainable practices has been nationally recognized with a White House Closing the Circle Award and he has twice received The Federal Energy Management Award. He is a licensed Hardhat Diver and Water Treatment Plant Operator.

He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Occupational Education from the Southern Illinois University and a Masters of Science in Quality Assurance from California State University, Dominguez Hills. His personal commitment to sustainability includes living in a solar powered home and driving biodiesel-powered vehicles.
