Heavy-Duty Drayage Truck Replacement Program

To: Dealership Representative

The purpose of this letter is to clarify the dealer's requirement to deliver the old trucks approved under the South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) Heavy-Duty Drayage Truck Replacement Program to an AQMD-approved dismantler.

The dealer must comply with the required timeline for delivering the old truck to an AQMD-approved dismantler as specified below:

- **Within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the old truck from the customer** if the truck replacement project involves a direct payment of the grant award from AQMD to the dealer, **OR**
- **Within ten (10) days of receipt of the new truck by the customer** if the project involves a customer seeking reimbursement of the grant award from AQMD on their own.

Participating dealers should be mindful of the shorter timeline that applies to old trucks from customers that will be seeking reimbursement of the grant award from AQMD on their own.

To verify the old truck is delivered to the dismantler in a timely manner, AQMD is requiring the dealer complete a Dealer Certification (see attached). This form must be signed and returned to AQMD at: **South Coast AQMD, Attn: Ana Troccoli, 21865 Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, CA 91765.**

The Dealer Certification form must be submitted to AQMD **within seven (7) business days of receipt of the old truck by the dealer, or may be submitted to AQMD along with the invoice.** Please be advised that failure to meet this request may delay processing of the invoice and, among other remedies, may result in your future disqualification from participating in the program.

Important Note: LNG trucks approved under this program are expected to receive grant funds from the AQMD, including funds from the U.S. Department of Energy, Clean Cities Program. These vehicles will be required to have a label that reads "This Vehicle is part of a U.S. DOE Clean Cities Award and Powered by Alternative Fuel." The AQMD may request your assistance to facilitate the placement of these labels on the vehicles.
