LARGE CONFINED ANIMAL FACILITY (LCAF) CONSISTING OF:

1. MILKING COWS, DRY COWS, HEIFERS AND CALVES
2. MILIKING PARLOR
3. DRY LOT SCRAPE/SLURRY VACUUM TYPE MANURE HANDLING SYSTEM
4. OPEN CORRALS WITH IN-CORRAL MOUNDS
5. SPECIAL NEED/CALIF HOUSING
6. FEED STORAGE COMMODITY BARNs
7. STATIONARY FEED MIXER
8. FEED TRUCK
9. TEN (10) STORAGE PONDS
10. TWO (2) SETTLING PONDS
11. OPEN MANURE STOCK PILES
12. WINDROW TYPE COMPOSTING OPERATION

Conditions :

1. OPERATION OF THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL DATA AND SPECIFICATIONS SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION UNDER WHICH THIS PERMIT IS ISSUED UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED BELOW.
2. THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE PROPERLY MAINTAINED AND KEPT IN GOOD OPERATING CONDITION AT ALL TIMES.

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3. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF MILKING COWS, DRY COWS, HEIFERS AND CALVES AT THIS FACILITY SHALL NOT EXCEED 3,410 ANIMALS IN ANY ONE DAY.
4. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF MILK-PRODUCING COWS AT THIS FACILITY SHALL NOT EXCEED 1,745 IN ANY ONE DAY.
5. THIS EQUIPMENT IS SUBJECT TO THE APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FOLLOWING RUELS AND REGULATIONS:

RULE 223 EMISSION REDUCTION PERMITS FOR LARGE CONFINED ANIMAL FACILITIES
RULE 1127 EMISSION REDUCTION FROM LIVESTOCK WASTE
RULE 1186 PM10 EMISSIONS FROM PAVED AND UNPAVED ROADS, AND LIVESTOCK OPERATIONS.
6. THIS OPERATOR SHALL USE BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES AT ALL TIMES IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 1127.
7. MANURE DISPOSED OF WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE DISTRICT SHALL ONLY BE REMOVED OR CONTRACTED TO BE REMOVED FROM THIS DAIRY TO:
 - A. AN APPROVED MANURE PROCESSING OPERATION; OR
 - B. AGRICULTURAL LAND WITHIN THE DISTRICT APPROVED BY LOCAL ORDINANCE, AND/OR REGIONAL WATER QUALITY BOARD FOR THE SPREADING OF MANURE; OR
 - C. COMBINATION OF DESTINATIONS IN A AND B.
8. THE OPERATOR SHALL MAINTAIN COPIES OF ALL MANURE MANIFESTS, TIPPING FEE INVOICES, MANURE MOISTURE TEST RECORDS, CORRAL CLEARING RECORDS, AND STOCKPILE REMOVAL RECORDS.
9. THE OPERATOR SHALL SUBMIT A WRITTEN ANNUAL REPORT BY JANUARY 15TH OF EACH YEAR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2008 PER THE REQUIREMENTS OF RULE 1127. THE REPORT SHALL BE SENT TO: SCAQMD, COMPLIANCE DIVISION, PO BOX 4941, DIAMOND BAR, CA 91765-0941.
10. THE OPERATOR SHALL:
 - A. CEASE ALL HAY GRINDING ACTIVITIES BETWEEN 2-5 PM IF VISIBLE EMISSIONS EXTEND MORE THAN 50 FT FROM A HAY GRINDING SOURCE, AND
 - B. TREAT UNPAVED ACCESS CONNECTION AND FEED LANE ACCESS AREAS WITH EITHER PAVEMENT, GRAVEL (MAINTAINED TO A DEPTH OF 4 INCHES), OR ASPHALTIC ROAD-BASE.

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11. THE OPERATOR SHALL IMPLEMENT THE RULE 223 CONTROL MEASURES IDENTIFIED IN THE APPROVED EMISSIONS MITIGATION PLAN PRIOR TO (ONE YEAR FROM PERMIT ISSUANCE.)
12. THE OPERATOR SHALL NOT LAND APPLY DRY OR LIQUID MANURE TO CROPLAND AT THIS FACILITY. LIQUID MANURE IS DEFINED AS LIQUID WASTE WITH A SOLID CONTENT OF 5 PERCENT OR LESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NRCS AGRICULTURAL WASTE MANAGEMENT HANDBOOK.
13. FEEDSTOCK MATERIAL FOR THE COMPOSTING CONDUCTED AT THIS FACILITY SHALL CONSIST ONLY OF WASTES GENERATED ON-SITE BY THE DAIRY OPERATIONS AT THIS LOCATION.
14. THE OPERATOR MAY TEMPORARILY SUSPEND IMPLEMENTATION OF PORTIONS OF THE DAIRY LCAF EMISSIONS MITIGATION PLAN PROVIDED REQUIREMENTS OF RULE 223(J)(2) ARE MET. NOTIFICATION TO THE DISTRICT SHALL BE MADE BY CALLING 1 800 CUT SMOG.
15. THE OPERATOR SHALL MAINTAIN RECORDS THAT SPECIFY THE MONTHLY AVERAGE NUMBER OF ANIMALS MAINTAINED AT THIS FACILITY.
16. THE OPERATOR SHALL MAINTAIN RECORDS, IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE DISTRICT, TO DEMONSTRATE COMPLIANCE WITH CODITION NOS. 3, 4, 7, 8 AND 15. THE RECORDS SHALL BE RETAINED AT THE FACILITY FOR AT LEAST THREE YEARS AND BE MADE AVAILABLE TO DISTRICT PERSONNEL UPON REQUEST.

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NOTICE

IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 206, THIS PERMIT TO OPERATE OR COPY SHALL BE POSTED ON OR WITHIN 8 METERS OF THE EQUIPMENT.

THIS PERMIT DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE EMISSION OF AIR CONTAMINANTS IN EXCESS OF THOSE ALLOWED BY DIVISION 26 OF THE HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OR THE RULES OF THE AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT. THIS PERMIT CANNOT BE CONSIDERED AS PERMISSION TO VIOLATE EXISTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, REGULATIONS OR STATUTES OF OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.
