Background

SCAQMD has been providing enhanced particulate monitoring support including sample collection as part of a national monitoring program since 2003 and will continue for the foreseeable future.

Proposal

SCAQMD was awarded \$2,100,000 from the U.S. Government for the ongoing Enhanced Particulate Monitoring Program and this amount has previously been included in SCAQMD's FY 2017-18 Budget. This action is to transfer up to \$180,000 in Science and Technology Advancement's FY 2017-18 budget from Salaries and Employee Benefits Major Object (Org 44), Salaries Account, to Services and Supplies Major Object (Org 47), Temporary Agency Account, to realign expenditures for the FY 2017-18 Enhanced Particulate Monitoring Program.

Resource Impacts

U.S. Government funding will fully support the Enhanced Particulate Monitoring Program. The \$180,000 transfer will realign expenditures for the FY 2017-18 Program.
