

Near-Term ARB Measures-Vessels

- Advocate with international partners for tighter IMO NOx/PM standards, plus efficiency targets for existing vessels (2015)
- 2. Define "Super Low-Emission Efficient Ship;" use incentives for advanced technologies (2016)
- 3. Expand existing At-Berth rule (2016)
