

shares similar scores across health and socioeconomic indicators




Applicants with an address within the ECV community boundary are eligible to receive a home air filter




To expedite the process, the Budget Working Team supports a first come, first served basis

Some CSC suggested criteria is not verifiable (as required by CARB) or cannot be used due to privacy concerns (e.g., cancer incidences)












