

## **Assembly Bill 617 (AB 617) Meeting Summary**

#### **CSC Meeting #8 – Draft CERP and CAMP Discussion**

South Coast AQMD staff presented the Discussion Draft Community Emissions Reduction Plan (CERP) and Community Air Monitoring Plan (CAMP), including the development process, timeline, contents, and actions for the SELA air quality priorities that include: truck traffic and freeways, rail yards and locomotives, metal processing facilities, rendering facilities, green spaces, and general industrial facilities. The CSC discussed the actions in the Discussion Draft CERP. Additionally, the CSC asked questions and provided comments on the next CERP draft.

CSC members asked for actions in the CERP to monitor emissions along the Alameda Corridor and incentivize cleaner technologies for small businesses. A CSC member also asked for a list of best available control technologies for industrial facilities in the community and requested clarification on collaboration with other agencies to plant vegetative buffers near freeways. A CSC member also asked when comments from the meeting will be addressed and reflected in the CERP for their review.

Staff responded by affirming that monitoring along the Alameda Corridor can be incorporated into the CERP and CAMP, highlighting outreach actions in CERP for independent truck owners and operators regarding incentives for cleaner trucks, and describing how to collaborate to expand vegetative buffers. Staff also explained that comments and suggestions from the meeting would be reflected in the following draft of the CERP.

Lastly staff notified attendees that we had modified the CSC schedule to now include an additional meeting date of November 18, as well as a CERP Question & Answer Session meeting on November 5.

Public Comment was then received from meeting attendees.
