**CALL TO ORDER:** Chair Delgado called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m.

- Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Board Member Kracov
- Roll Call

Board Member Padilla-Campos and Councilmember Raman were not present for roll call. Councilmember Raman joined the meeting at 9:06 a.m. and Board Member Padilla-Campos at 9:25 a.m.

- Swearing in of Newly Appointed Board Members Supervisor Janet Nguyen and Councilmember Brenda Olmos.

Chair Delgado administered the Oath of Office to the newly elected Board Members: Supervisor Janet Nguyen, who was appointed by the Orange County Board of Supervisors, for a term ending January 2027; and Councilmember Brenda Olmos, who was appointed by the Los Angeles County City Selection Committee Western Region, for a term ending January 2026.

Councilmember Olmos and Supervisor Nguyen spoke about their careers in public service and as elected officials.

- Recognition of Outgoing Board Member

Chair Delgado announced the resignation of Board Member Kracov from the Board effective April 3, 2025. Board Member Kracov was acknowledged for his accomplishments and service on the Board from February 2020 to April 2025 as the Governor's appointee.

Board Member Kracov expressed appreciation for the opportunity to serve on the Board and acknowledged the legacy of the agency and leadership of past and present Board Members. Board Members thanked Board Member Kracov for his service and contributions to the Board.

- Opening Comments

Executive Officer Wayne Nastri announced the following: a Technology Showcase today in the South Coast AQMD parking lot to display the latest advancements in clean air technology, as well as mobile monitoring equipment; closing of the application period for this year's Summer Internship program; the April 4th Board Meeting being held offsite at the Palm Desert Council Chamber; and the opening of the application period for the Lower-Emission School Bus Program. Executive Officer Nastri provided an update on efforts for the Palisades and Eaton wildfires regarding air quality monitoring, placement of monitoring stations, and real time data available on the South Coast AQMD website. Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez shared that it has been an honor and privilege to serve as the Technology Committee Chair, thanked staff for their hard work in organizing today's Technology Showcase, and commented on some of the technologies on display at the showcase.

Key topics raised by the above speakers included:

**Port ISR**

- Commented on pollution generated by the ports that disproportionately harms port communities and those in the Inland Empire;
- Advocated for a strong Port ISR with clear timelines and enforceable emission reduction goals and targets, not just expanding charging and fueling infrastructure without clear standards;
- Concerned that draft rule language considers hydrogen as a zero-emission solution
- Supports the inclusion of a "no-automation" clause to protect workers.
- Urged the Board for no further delays to adopting the Port ISR

**PAR 1111 and PAR 1121**

- Expressed support for strong rules
- PARs 1111 and 1121 must be strengthened by requiring mitigation fees and accelerating the timeline for manufacturers to bring zero-NOx units to the market sooner;
- Expressed disappointment with the latest draft proposals of PARs 1111 and 1121 that significantly weakens the expected emission reductions;
- Expressed concern that comments during outreach forums create misinformation; and
- Urged the Board for no further delays to adopting PARs 1111 and 1121.

Thomas Jelenić, Pacific Merchant Shipping Association, thanked the Board for the Port ISR's focus on infrastructure and commented on the significant reduction in diesel emissions the Ports have already achieved. For additional details, please refer to the [Webcast](#) beginning at 52:33.

**19. Permitting Enhancement Program Status Update (Presentation in Lieu of Board Letter)**

Jason Aspell, Deputy Executive Officer/Engineering & Permitting, gave the staff presentation on Agenda Item No. 19. For additional details, please refer to the Webcast beginning at 1:22:28.

In response to Chair Delgado, Jason Aspell explained the South Coast AQMD's Certified Permitting Professional (CPP) program. For additional details, please refer to the [Webcast](#) beginning at 1:38:10.

Supervisor Mitchell expressed that she was interested in getting more information about the CPP at the next PEP update. For additional details, please refer to the [Webcast](#) beginning at 1:38:55.

Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez, Councilmember Raman, and Mayor Pro Tem McCallon thanked the Chair for bringing this issue forward and expressed appreciation of staff's progress.

Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez commented that he would like to see the public notification pilot program move to full implementation and expressed concern about the old permitting software. He asked when staff anticipates having a cost estimate for developing a state-of-the-art software permitting program, and at which universities the staff has established a pipeline to develop potential candidates for future job openings. Jason Aspell responded that staff is implementing the revised public notification process, and explained that staff is working on the workflow details for an enhanced permitting system and looking at internal and third-party options, and that staff works with local universities to build a talent pipeline. Vice Chair Cacciotti asked whether sufficient funds have been budgeted to hire consultants/contractors and what type of work the consultants are performing to assist staff. He expressed support for hiring more consultants, if it can be kept within budget. Mr. Aspell responded that staff is working with two contractors that are conducting air quality modeling, reviewing CEQA documents, and processing permit applications. He explained that retired engineers can no longer be used, so money budgeted for the retirees is being used for contractors. Councilmember Raman explained metrics that the City of Los Angeles uses for housing permits, and asked about the type of metrics that South Coast AQMD uses to measure staff time. Mr. Aspell provided examples of metrics and explained that a new updated system would allow staff to extract more metrics such as residency times and metrics that the Councilmember is referencing. Councilmember Raman asked for additional clarification and the importance of knowing what the backlog was before, average completion time, and permitting goals, and requested that staff provide this information in the next PEP update. Mr. Aspell explained that the inventory in 2016 was over 7,600 permit applications, and the total inventory today is 5,100 permit applications. Executive Officer Nastri added that it is also important to recognize the complexity and U.S. EPA's review process for Title V permits, and that staff is working to address issues in permitting that have been raised by U.S. EPA. Mayor Pro Tem McCallon asked about the 20 percent increase in permits "awaiting action" between October and January. Mr. Aspell explained that "awaiting action" refers to permit actions that staff cannot proceed with processing and that many of these projects have already received a Permit to Construct and are waiting for emissions source testing or completion of construction to receive the Permit to Operate. Mayor Pro Tem McCallon pointed out that this increase shows some of the progress that has been made in issuing permits. For additional details, please refer to the [Webcast](#) beginning at 1:53:56.

Supervisor Hagman suggested outsourcing some of the permitting process when there is a backlog to minimize having excess staff when the backlog decreases and offering an expedited process for an additional charge. Executive Officer Nastri explained that there is currently an expedited permit processing option and there are requirements on the back end that result in the backlog such as source testing which takes time and is a factor in the delays. Regarding outsourcing, Executive Officer Nastri explained that staff is looking at all options and opportunities to continue to make progress. Chair Delgado thanked Mr. Aspell for stepping up and handling this huge task. She commented that the faster that staff can get people through the permitting process, the faster emissions can be reduced. For additional details, please refer to the [Webcast](#) beginning at 1:59:52.
