Please see my edits to the attached Proposed Conditions, 3, 6 &12.

- 1. Submit root cause analysis report
- 2. Maintain a minimum flow rate to scrubber of 600 gpm. This was based on a Case No 6258-1 for a similar issue, failure of SOx analyzer about the same time last year.

Case No 6258-1 - Question and response to scrubber flow

What minimum flow rate needs to be maintained for the scrubber? Since the reporting of the scrubber flow is a condition, as well as the pH, should the flow rate also be listed beside the pH in the proposed condition?

The condition has been revised to include a minimum flow rate of 600 gpm. If the flow rate goes below this level, an alarm will be triggered and the District will be notified.

Please let me know if these revised conditions are acceptable. Thanks.

Thank you. We have updated the draft of the proposed order and findings to include the requested language (in track changes).

As for the question, the SOx analyzer continues to exhibit abnormal behavior. In the week since passing calibration, there have nonetheless been a significantly higher rate of zero and span daily calibrations that are much closer to failure than normal, while technically still passing. Further, both analyzers malfunctioned at the same time, suggesting that there may be a shared root cause. Despite intensive efforts since the malfunctions, the root cause of the breakdowns has not yet been identified. As such, the Health and Safety Code section 42352(a)(1) criterion—that a petitioner is or will be in violation—is satisfied, as there is good reason to believe that the SOx analyzer (although presently back in control) is at material risk of soon failing calibration again.
