1 With regard to Petitioner's internal combustion engine emergency generator (P/O G66914),
2 (Facility ID No. 195306), located at 1490 Rubidoux Blvd., Jurupa Valley, CA, 92509, CalPortland
3 Co. ("Petitioner") and the South Coast Air Quality Management District ("South Coast AQMD" or
4 "Respondent") (collectively, the "Parties") hereby request that Case No. 3221-23, the Petition for a
5 Regular Variance ("Petition"), scheduled for a public hearing on April 23, 2025 at 9:30 a.m., be
6 placed on that date's consent calendar. Pursuant to Hearing Board Rule 4(a), the Parties stipulate
7 to the following:

- 8 1. The Parties agree to have the matter placed on the consent calendar for April 23,
9 2025 at 9:30 a.m.
- 10 2. The Parties agree that the Declaration of Leanna East (filed concurrently herewith),
11 shall be admitted into evidence.
- 12 3. The Parties agree that all prior evidence in this matter, including from the decision
13 to grant an Ex Parte Emergency Variance, the decision to grant an Interim Variance,
14 and all previously submitted exhibits shall be incorporated by reference into this
15 hearing.
- 16 4. The Parties have agreed on the [Proposed] Findings and Decision and Order Granting
17 a Regular Variance (the "[Proposed] Order") (filed concurrently herewith).
- 18 5. The South Coast AQMD does not oppose granting the regular variance.
- 19 6. Petitioner's operation under the [Proposed] Order is not expected to result in a
20 violation of Health and Safety Code Section 41700 / South Coast AQMD Rule 402.
- 21 7. The Parties may execute and deliver this Stipulation by transmitting an authorized
22 signature by fax or .pdf document. Copies of this Stipulation signed and delivered
23 by means of faxed signatures or signatures in a .pdf document shall have the same
24 effect as copies executed and delivered with original signatures.
