18 The undersigned parties, Petitioner Canyon Power Plant (City of Anaheim) and
19 Respondent South Coast Air Quality Management District ("District"), referred to jointly as
20 "Parties," stipulate and agree as follows:

22 1. The Parties agree to have this matter placed on the Hearing Board's Consent
23 Calendar for Thursday, September 4, 2025, pursuant to Hearing Board Rule 4(a)(4).

2. The Petitioner seeks an extension of the compliance deadlines in the Regular Variance issued by the Hearing Board on October 3, 2024, which provides relief until August 31, 2025, from District Rules 203(b), 2004(f)(1), and 3002(c)(1), and Condition D29.3 of the Permit for Facility ID No. 153992, as applicable to Device No. D1 ("Gas Turbine No. 1").

3. The Parties agree to have the Declarations of Ron Hoffard and Elden Krause (filed concurrently with this Stipulation) admitted into evidence regarding this matter.

4. The Parties have agreed on a (Proposed) Findings and Decision Order (filed concurrently with this Stipulation).

5. The District does not oppose Petitioner's request for the granting of a variance extending the compliance date of the Regular Variance granted in Case No. 6264-1.

6. The Parties agree to incorporate prior evidence and testimony from the Hearing on Petitioner's Petition for a Regular Variance, heard on October 3, 2024, as Case No. 6264-1, for which a Variance was granted until August 31, 2025.

7. Operation under the order is not expected to result in a violation of Health and Safety Code Section 41700 (nuisance).

8. The Parties request that the Hearing Board decide the matter based on this Stipulation, the Declaration, the Findings and Decision and Order, and the prior evidence and testimony from the hearing on October 3, 2024.
