The parties, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (“South Coast AQMD” or “Respondent”) and County of Riverside (“County” or “Petitioner”) do hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. This matter may be placed on the Hearing Board’s Consent Calendar to be heard on July 28, 2026, pursuant to Rule 4(a)(4) of the Rules and Procedures of the South Coast Air Quality Management District Hearing Board;

2. The Petitioner previously sought and received an Interim Variance from the provisions of South Coast AQMD Rule 203(b) for the specific permit conditions listed in the attached (Proposed

3. The Petitioner now seeks a Regular Variance from the provisions of South Coast AQMD Rule 203(b) for the specific permit condition listed in the attached (Proposed) Order.

4. The declaration of Aaron DeGuzman, dated 7/15/2026 entered into evidence in support of Petitioner's Findings and Order (Stipulated);

5. Excess emissions calculations remain unchanged and are attached here as Respondent's Exhibit A.

6. The parties have agreed on the proposed Findings and Decision and Proposed Order (filed concurrently with this Stipulation) which may be submitted to the Hearing Board in support of the Petition for a Regular Variance;

7. The parties request the Hearing Board to decide this matter based upon the documents submitted by the parties, before the Hearing Board of the South Coast AQMD; the Declaration of Aaron DeGuzman; excess emissions calculations (Respondent's Exhibit A); and, the Proposed Findings and Decision and Proposed Order;

8. The District does not oppose the granting of the petition for a Regular Variance;

9. The parties agree that operation under the Order is not expected to result in a violation of California Health and Safety Code Section 41700;

10. Based on all of the evidence in this case, the parties stipulate to the Hearing Board decide this matter on the Consent Calendar.
