**Equipment Description :**

SPRAY BOOTH, AUTOMOTIVE CROSSDRAFT TYPE, 14'-0" W. X 28'-0" L. X 12'-0" H., WITH EIGHTEEN  
20" X 20" EXHAUST FILTERS AND ONE 3-H.P. EXHAUST FAN.

**Conditions :**

1. OPERATION OF THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL DATA AND SPECIFICATIONS SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION UNDER WHICH THIS PERMIT IS ISSUED UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED BELOW.
2. THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE PROPERLY MAINTAINED AND KEPT IN GOOD OPERATING CONDITION AT ALL TIMES.
3. THIS SPRAY BOOTH SHALL NOT BE OPERATED UNLESS ALL EXHAUST AIR PASSES THROUGH FILTER MEDIA AT LEAST 2 INCHES THICK.
4. A GAUGE SHALL BE INSTALLED AND MAINTAINED TO INDICATE, IN INCHES OF WATER, THE STATIC PRESSURE DIFFERENTIAL ACROSS THE EXHAUST FILTERS. IN OPERATION, THE PRESSURE DIFFERENTIAL SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.25 INCHES OF WATER.
5. THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE OPERATED IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULES 1151, 1171 AND 1401.1.
6. MATERIALS USED IN THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT CONTAIN ANY CARCINOGENIC AIR CONTAMINANTS IDENTIFIED IN RULE 1401, TABLE 1 WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF SEPTEMBER 10, 2010 OR EARLIER, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF NAPHTHALENE (CAS NO. 91-20-3), FORMALDEHYDE (CAS NO. 50-00-0) AND ETHYL BENZENE (CAS NO. 100-41-4), AS SPECIFIED IN CONDITION NO. 7.
7. THE CARCINOGENIC AIR CONTAMINANT CONTENT BY WEIGHT IN MATERIALS USED IN THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT EXCEED THE FOLLOWING:

NAPHTHALENE .....	0.1%, AS SUPPLIED
FORMALDEHYDE .....	0.1%, AS SUPPLIED
ETHYL BENZENE .....	1.5%, AS SUPPLIED



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8. THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF MATERIALS CONTAINING CARCINOGENIC AIR CONTAMINANTS USED IN THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT EXCEED 113 GALLONS, AS SUPPLIED, IN ANY ONE CALENDAR YEAR.
9. THE OPERATOR SHALL KEEP ADEQUATE RECORDS TO VERIFY THE CALENDAR YEARLY THROUGHPUT OF MATERIALS CONTAINING ETHYL BENZENE TO DEMONSTRATE COMPLIANCE WITH CONDITION NO. 8.
10. THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS (VOC) EMISSIONS FROM THIS EQUIPMENT AND ASSOCIATED OPERATIONS SHALL BE LESS THAN 53 POUNDS IN ANY ONE CALENDAR MONTH. ASSOCIATED OPERATIONS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, SURFACE PREPARATION, EQUIPMENT CLEAN-UP, AND THE APPLICATION OF ANY OTHER MATERIALS TO PARTS THAT ARE PREVIOUSLY OR SUBSEQUENTLY PROCESSED IN THE PERMITTED EQUIPMENT.
11. THE OPERATOR SHALL COMPLY WITH RULE 109 (RECORDKEEPING FOR VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUND EMISSIONS).
12. IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF RULE 109, THE OPERATOR SHALL KEEP ADEQUATE RECORDS FOR THIS EQUIPMENT TO VERIFY THE CALENDAR MONTHLY VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUND (VOC) EMISSIONS IN POUNDS AND THE VOC CONTENT OF EACH MATERIAL AS APPLIED (INCLUDING WATER AND EXEMPT COMPOUNDS). ALL RECORDS SHALL BE PREPARED IN A FORMAT WHICH IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE DISTRICT.
13. WITHIN 14 CALENDAR DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH MONTH, THE OPERATOR SHALL TOTAL AND RECORD VOC EMISSIONS FOR THE MONTH FROM ALL EQUIPMENT COVERED BY THE MONTHLY LIMIT. THE RECORD SHALL INCLUDE ANY PROCEDURES USED TO ACCOUNT FOR CONTROL DEVICE EFFICIENCIES AND/OR WASTE DISPOSAL. IT SHALL BE SIGNED AND CERTIFIED FOR ACCURACY BY THE HIGHEST RANKING INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLIANCE WITH DISTRICT RULES.
14. THE OPERATOR SHALL MAINTAIN A SINGLE LIST THAT INCLUDES ONLY THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH PERSON FROM WHOM THE FACILITY ACQUIRED VOC-CONTAINING MATERIAL REGULATED BY THE DISTRICT THAT WAS USED OR STORED AT THE FACILITY DURING THE PRECEDING 12 MONTHS.
15. THE OPERATOR SHALL RETAIN FOR 24 MONTHS ALL PURCHASE INVOICES FOR ALL VOC-CONTAINING MATERIAL USED OR STORED AT THE FACILITY, AND WASTE MANIFESTS FOR ALL WASTE VOC-CONTAINING MATERIAL REMOVED FROM THE FACILITY.
16. MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS FOR ALL COATINGS AND SOLVENTS USED AT THIS FACILITY AND SUBJECT TO DISTRICT RULES SHALL BE KEPT CURRENT AND MADE AVAILABLE TO DISTRICT PERSONNEL UPON REQUEST.

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17. ALL RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS PERMIT SHALL BE RETAINED AT THE FACILITY FOR 24 MONTHS, AND SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ANY DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVE UPON REQUEST.

**NOTICE**

IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 206, THIS PERMIT TO OPERATE OR COPY SHALL BE POSTED ON OR WITHIN 8 METERS OF THE EQUIPMENT.

THIS PERMIT DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE EMISSION OF AIR CONTAMINANTS IN EXCESS OF THOSE ALLOWED BY DIVISION 26 OF THE HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OR THE RULES OF THE AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT. THIS PERMIT CANNOT BE CONSIDERED AS PERMISSION TO VIOLATE EXISTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, REGULATIONS OR STATUTES OF OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.
