With regard to the Stipulated Modified Order for Abatement against Respondent Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (“LA Metro” or “Respondent”) regarding its fleet of heavy duty vehicles subject to South Coast AQMD Rule 1196, Respondent and Petitioner South Coast Air Quality Management District (“South Coast AQMD” or “Petitioner”) (collectively, the “Parties”) hereby request that that the Status / Modification Hearing for a Stipulated Modified Order for Abatement in Case No. 5874-2, scheduled for a public hearing on February 24, 2026 at 9:30 am, be placed on that date’s consent calendar. Pursuant to Hearing Board Rule 4(a), the Parties stipulate

1 to the following:

- 2 1. The Parties agree to have the matter placed on the consent calendar for February 24,
3 2026 at 9:30 a.m.
- 4 2. The Declaration of Alan Tang (filed concurrently herewith) shall be admitted into
5 evidence.
- 6 3. All prior evidence in this matter, including from the hearing July 21, 2021 granting a
7 Stipulated Order for Abatement, and the hearings July 28, 2022 , July 27, 2023, and
8 July 24, 2024 granting a Stipulated Modified Order for Abatement shall be
9 incorporated by reference into this hearing.
- 10 4. The Parties jointly request a stipulated modification to revise the end of jurisdiction
11 to be December 31, 2029, and to set a further status hearing for July 28, 2026.
- 12 5. The Parties have agreed on the [Proposed] Findings and Decision (filed concurrently
13 herewith) which captures all Parties' proposed modifications.
- 14 6. Respondent's operation under the Stipulated Modified Order for Abatement is not
15 expected to result in violation of California Health & Safety Code Section 41700 or
16 South Coast AQMD Rule 402.
- 17 7. The Parties may execute and deliver this Stipulation by transmitting an authorized
18 signature by fax or .pdf document. Copies of this Stipulation signed and delivered by
19 means of faxed signatures or signatures in a .pdf document shall have the same effect
20 as copies executed and delivered with original signatures.
